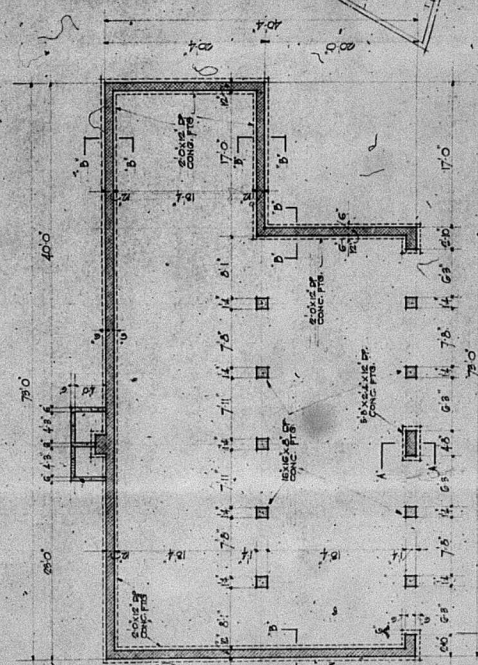

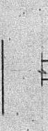

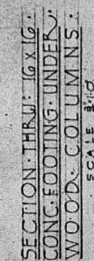

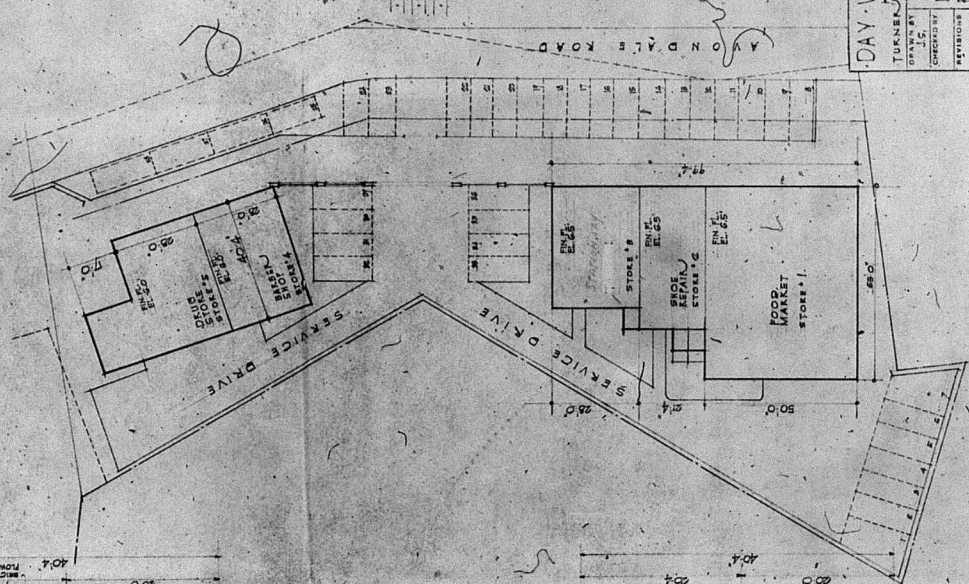

PLAN

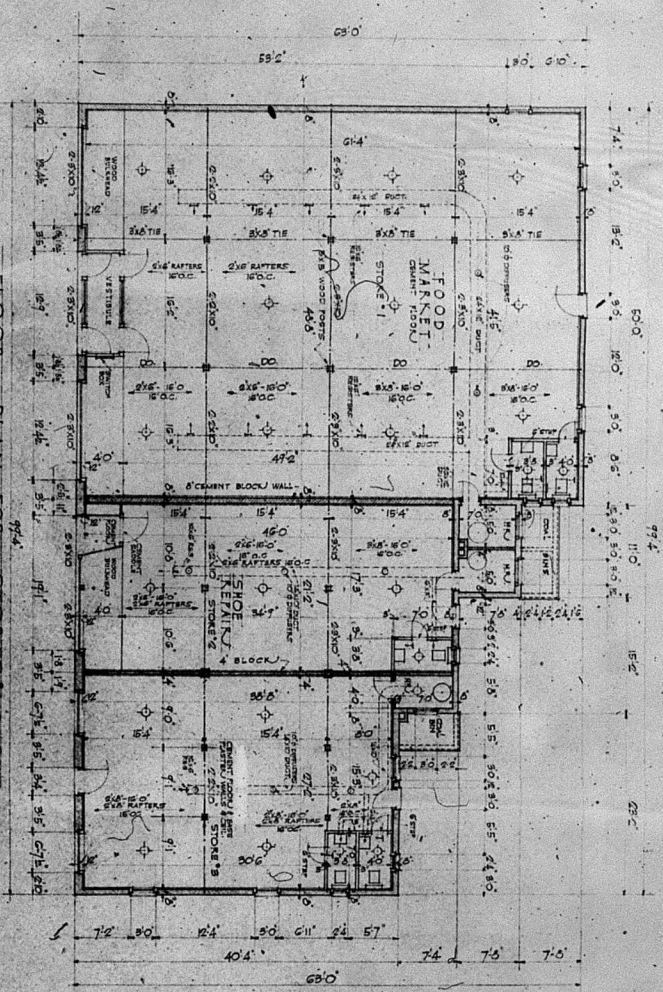


SECTION THRU: 16 x 16.

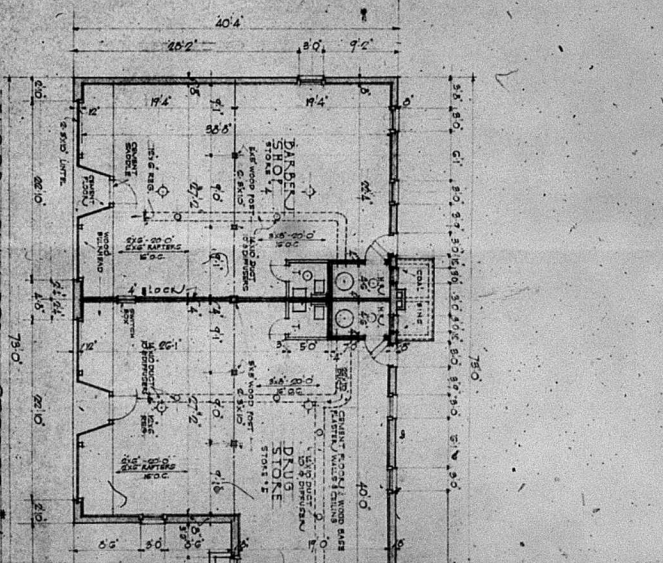

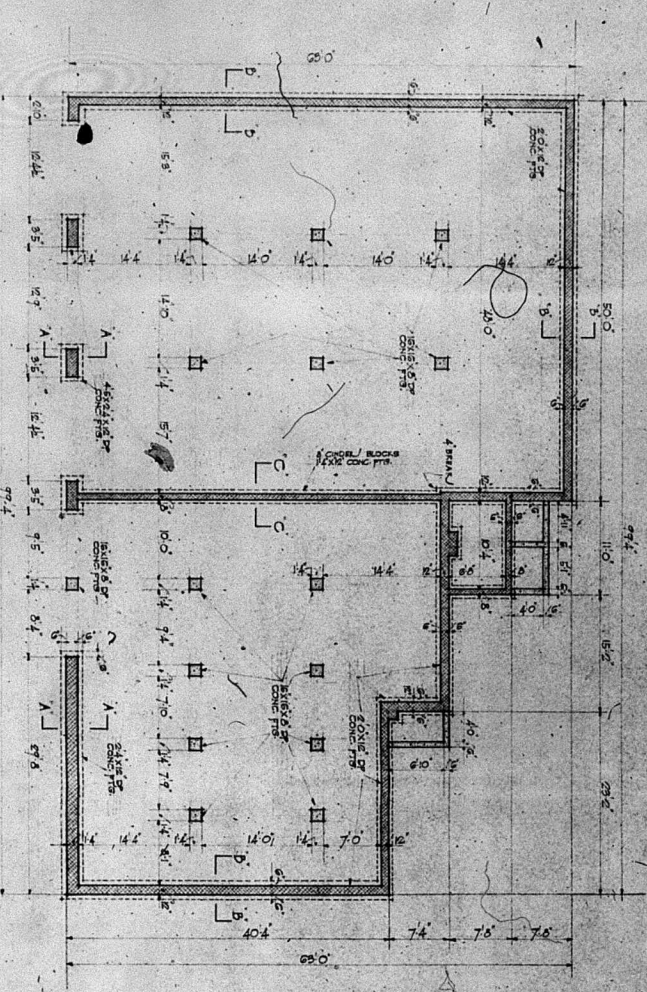

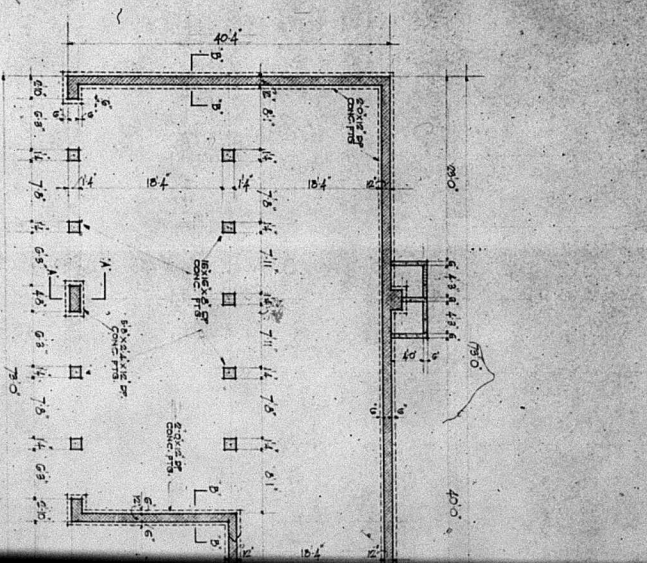
FLOOR PLAN FOR STORES 1-50

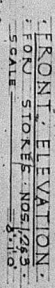
FLOOR PLAN FOR STORES 1-4

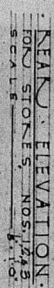
FOUNDATION PLAN

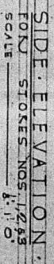
FOUNDATION PLAN

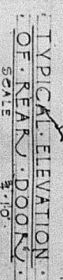
FRONT ELEVATION

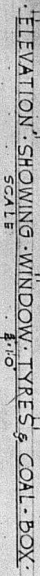
MEAN ELEVATION.

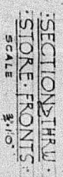
SIDE ELEVATION
