hereby petition for a Special Permit, under the Zoning Regulations and restrictions passed by the County Commissioners of Baltimore County, agreeable to Chapter 877 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1943, for a certain special permit and use, as provided under said Regulations and Act, as follows:

A Special Permit to use the land (and improvements now or to be erected thereon) hereinafter described for a Automobile Trailer Camp

situate on the northernmost side of Sulphur Spring Road, near "Ans-downs", in the 13th Election District of Balto. Co., beginning 700' east of Washington Boulevard, thence easterly, on said side of Sulphur Road, 140.3' to the S 14° W 444.3 feet line of land of Augusta E. and John Ammond, thence on the outlines of said above mentioned land, the five following courses and distances: N 13° W 434.14' N 63° W 282', S 25° W 176.31', S 70° S' E 125.4' and S 24° 00' W 131', thence for line of division S 68° 21' E 72.4' and S 16° 18' W 187' to beginning. Being all that lot of land in deed dated June 27, 1945 was conveyed by Augusta E. Ammond and John Ammond, her husband, to Patrick H. Lawson, Jr.,

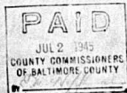

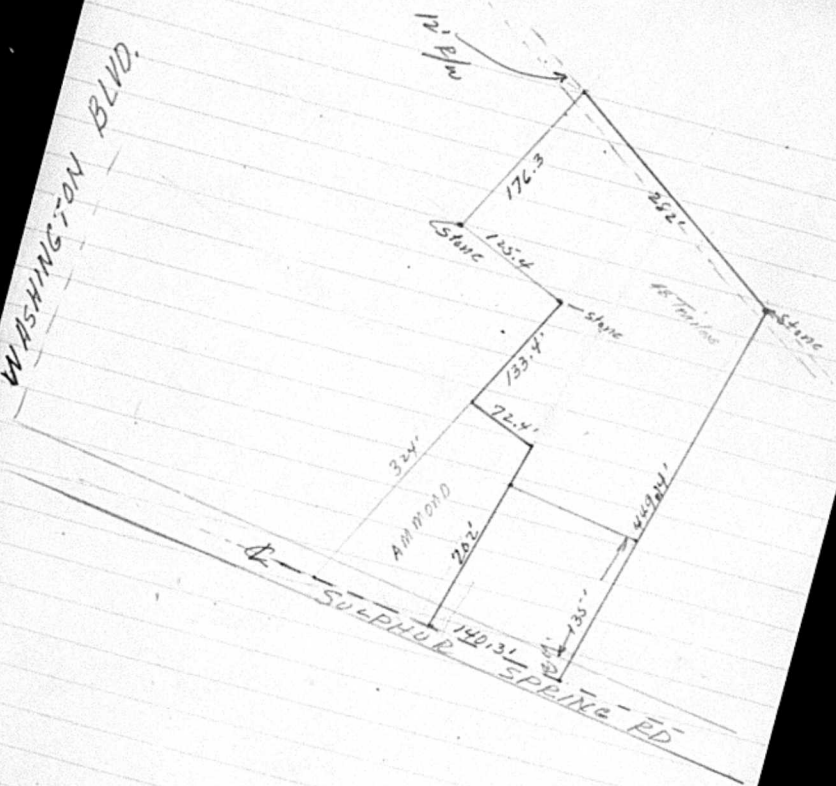

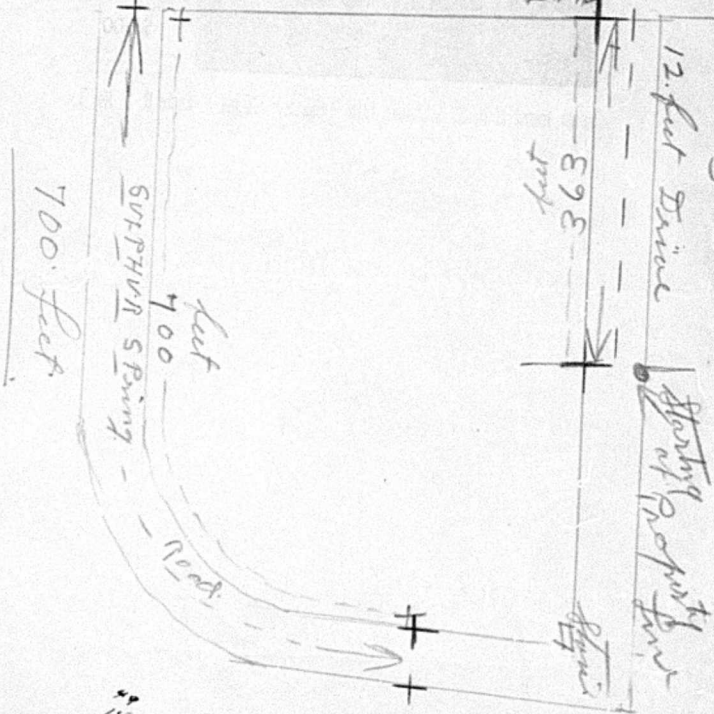
