 it appearing that by reason of location the said petition should
 be granted, therefore:

 The granting of this special permit is made subject to and
 with the compliance that the setback of pumps, service station
 and other structures shall conform to the plot plan as approved
 by the State Roads Commission and filed and made a part of this
 Order; the setback of pumps not to be nearer than 12 feet from
 the northwesterly right-of-way line of Pulaski Highway nor
 nearer than 12 feet from the southerly right-of-way line of
 Ebenezer Road and that the setback of the service building shall
 not be nearer than 67 feet from the said right-of-way line of
 Pulaski Highway nor nearer than 40' from the southwesterly
 right-of-way line of Ebenezer Road.

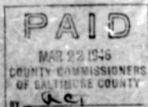
