It is this 10th day of July, 1947, ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County that the hereinafter described property, or area, should be and the same is hereby reclassified from and after the date of this Order from a "D" Residence Zone to an "A" Residence Zone. The property thus Reclassified as follows:

BEGINNING for the same on the west side of Symington Ave., as proposed to be laid out 50' wide at a point distant 105' northerly, measured along the west line of said Symington Ave., from the northeast side of Maiden Choice Lane and running thence northerly and binding on the west side of said Symington Avenue a distance of 127', thence leaving said Symington Avenue running in a southeasterly direction a distance of 129' to intersect the west line of said Maiden Choice Lane, thence easterly from the northeast side of Maiden Choice Lane, thence southeasterly and binding on said last mentioned line a distance of 34' to the place of beginning.

beginning for the same at the point of intersection of a line drawn 600' northeasterly and at right angles to the northeast side of Wallen Choke Lane from a point on the northeast side of the road, and a line drawn 560' southeast of Foreast ave. and a line drawn parallel to and distant 100' southeasterly from the southwest N 20° E 20' line. The line proposed, as proposed to be widened 30' and running thence northing and southing, thence S 49° 00' 30" E 180' to intersect the northeast side of a 15 ft. alley as proposed to be laid out parallel to and distant 100' southeasterly from the southwest N 20° E 20' line, and then southing and southing to Grove Road, thence in a westerly direction on a curve to the northeast with a radius of 16,000' for a distance of 121' to intersect the aforementioned 600' line, thence northeasterly, winding on said 600' line, a distance of 98' to the place of beginning.
