after Inspection of the United Clay Mines Corporation property and its general vicinity, I believe that the requested reclassification is quite justifiable and highly desirable from the standpoint of County planning. The present established operations of this ompary lie in a rather narrow strip between the S. & O. Railroad and U. S. WO, a mal-lame expressway that is part of the Federal Interregional Highway System. Use of this strip for industry appears such more appropriate than for residences. It seems preferable to read-side commercial uses which tend to interfere more or with the safest and most efficient use of such an important highway.
