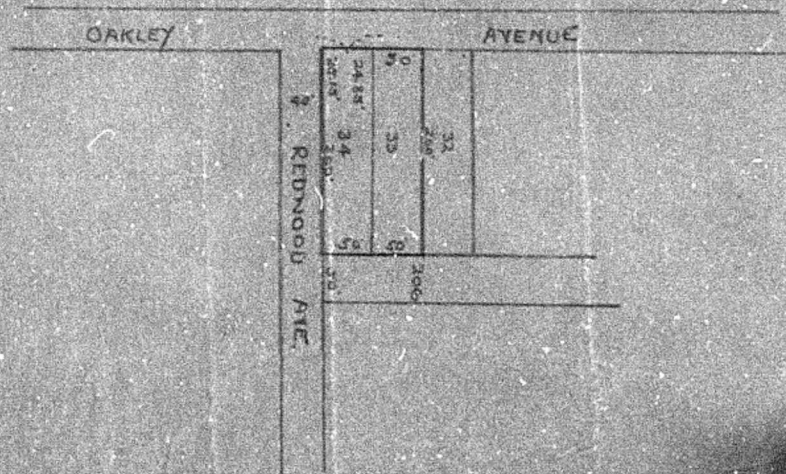


HILLENDALE FARMS

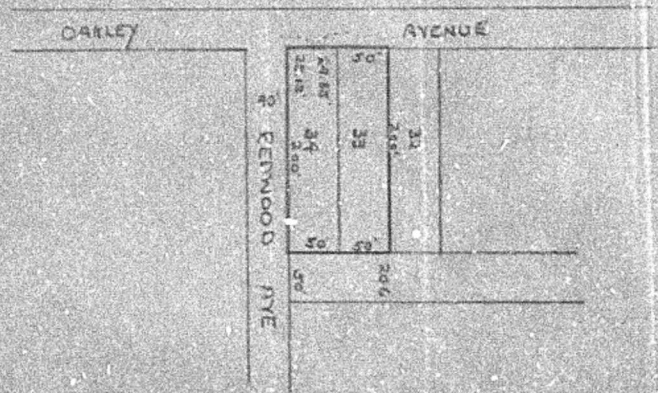
