A ~~Special~~ Permit to use the land (and improvements now
or to be erected thereon) hereinafter described for 5 Advertising Structures

each 12' x 25'

Three parcels of land in the 15th District of Balto. Co., described
as follows:

- (1) West side of Old North Point Road, beginning 400' south of North
Point Boulevard, thence southerly, on the west side of Old North
Point, 25 feet with a rectangular depth westerly of 50 feet.
- (2) East side of North Point Boulevard, beginning 700' south of Old
North Point Road, thence southerly, on the east side of North Point
Boulevard, 25 feet with a rectangular depth easterly of 50 feet.
- (3) East side of North Point Boulevard, beginning 1200' south of Old
North Point Road, thence southerly, on the east side of North Point
Boulevard, 25 feet with a rectangular depth easterly of 50 feet.

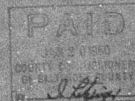
