Temporary Use hereby petition for a Special Permit, under the Zoning Regulations and Restrictions passed by the County Commissioners of Baltimore County, agreeable to Chapter 877 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1943, for a certain permit and use, as provided under said Regulations and act, as follows:

Temporary Use A Special Permit to use the land (and improvements now or to be erected thereon) hereinafter described for Advertising Signs - ca 12' x 25' east side of North Point Boulevard, beginning 230' south of Battle Grove Road, thence southerly, on the east side of North Point Boulevard, 25 feet with a rectangular depth easterly of 50 feet

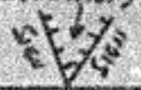
