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OPINION OF THE BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS
OF BALTIMORE COUNTY

This is an appeal by Dr. Edward F. Kerman, owner of the property described in the petition from an Order and decision of the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County deted August 25, 1950 by which Order the petition for special permit to use the property described therein for a hospital was denied.
