 a period of two (2) years from the above date.

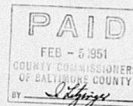

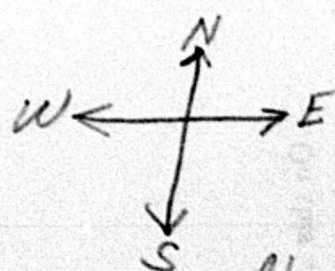
