

RE: APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC EXHIBITION LICENSE
FOR MOTORCYCLE RACES - Belmont Avenue -
First District of Baltimore County

A hearing was held before the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County on September 3, 1952 to determine whether or not an application for a public exhibition license for the conduct of motorcycle races on Belmont Avenue, First District, on October 19, 1952, should be approved by the Zoning Department of Baltimore County. The Baltimore Ramblers Motorcycle Club, Inc., the applicant for this license, has conducted such exhibition at various places in Baltimore County prior to this.

At the hearing on this matter two persons appeared in addition to Mr. T. H. Kane, the representative of the Motorcycle Club. Those persons consisted of Mrs. Jeanette Rowe and Mr. William E. Steigelman, President of the North Rolling Road Association. Mrs. Rowe and Mr. Steigelman appeared not as protestants but more as to the nature of the hearing. After Mr. Kane explained to those persons that the license sought was for a one day exhibition on October 19, 1952 and explained the nature of the event and the distribution of the receipts, no protests to the approval of this exhibition license were presented by either Mrs. Rowe or Mr. Steigelman. It was the feeling of both that such an exhibition for one day would not be detrimental to the general welfare of the community and, therefore, it will be proper for the Zoning Commissioner to approve the application for the public exhibition license.

It is the opinion of the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County that the application for public exhibition license should be approved as to zoning, subject to the following provisions and restrictions:

1. That no loud speakers shall be used before 12:45 or after 5:00 p.m. and that no music shall be played over said loud speaker system and that said system shall be toned down to the lowest extent commensurate with proper operation.

2. That no motorcycle motors shall be tested or tried out before 12:00 Noon.

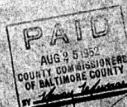
