A hearing was held before the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimere County on Herch 13, 1851 to determine whether or not an Application for a Public Edithitist In License for the conduct of motorcycle races, at Carroll and Stockton Roads, in the Teath District, should be approved by the Zoning Department of Bultimore County.

The Bultimore Hamblers Motorcycle Club, Incorporated, the applicant for this license, quoducted two such exhibitions on the site in question in 1800; applications for the public exhibition licenses for these exhibitions having been approved by the Zoning Department of Bultimore County.

Subsequent to the issuance of the licenses by the Clerk of the Court for Baltimers County for the conduct of these exhibitions, the symicant incurred considerable expense in contracting a quarter mile track and making other minor improvements. Also, subsequent to the conduct of the roces in 1800 considerable completing was logged with this apportment conserving the conduct of these activities.

Considering the above complaints this hearing was held to determine the facts in the case so that the pending application could be passed upon.

Complaints from the residents in the neighborhood consist of the following:

 That on the day of the race much congestion is generated on the narrow roads in the neighborhood resulting in actual heard to life and limb of local residents. The noise of the motorcycles and the loud speaker used at the exhibitions are very annoying and disturbing to the residents.

 Lack of adequate sanitary facilities to prevent contemination of local water supplies and the Loch Raven Watershed.

It is the opinion of the Zoning Comissioner that due to the fact that these spylications for licenses were approved by the Zoning Department of Estimore County in 1850 and said licenses were issued by the Clark of the Court and that the spylicant has gone to considerable expense in preparing a truck for the conduct of these receased in view of the shortage of time slowed the applicant to find enother site, this application should be approved by this Department, subject to the following provisions and restrictions:

- 1. That no load speakers shall be used on the property before 12:45 p. m. or after 5:00 p.m.; that no music shall be played over said load speaker system and that said system shall be toned down to the lowest extent commensurate with proper operation.
- That no motorcycle motors shall be tested or tried out before 12:00 Noon.
- That toilet facilities be provided for 2000 people as required by the Health Department of Baltimore County.
- That the entrance to this site on Stockton Road be barricaded with barbed wire or some other suitable fencing at all times except on the day of the two races.
- The locitors be written to the other clubs invited to participate in these shiftitions notifying these of the reference and the same state of the same state
