The property which is the subject of this petition is located on the west side of Marks Avenue, beginning 300 feet south of Henry Avenue, 11th District, having a frontage of 85 feet with rectangular depth of 150 feet. The use for which this petition is requested is for the operation of a Day Nursery.

Evidence produced at the hearing was to the effect that a Day Nursery is needed in this area. Many of the mothers are employed and it is necessary that they have some place to leave their children during the day. From information received it is evident that Mrs. Vitek has had vast experience in this type of work and is well qualified to operate a Day Nursery.

It is the opinion of the Acting Zoning Commissioner that the granting of a special permit for the operation of a Private School, (Day Nursery) would not be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of the Community and the special permit petitioned should be granted.

It is this 28th day of October, 1952, ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County, that the aforesaid special permit be and the same is hereby granted, subject, however, to the restricting of the number of children using this service to thirty (30) children.
