Upon hearing upon the foregoing petition for a special permit, it is hereby determined that the permit should be denied for the following reasons:

- 1. The nearby residents complain that a Day Nursery with 27 children would be a disturbing element in their
- 2. This use would have a tendency to depreciate the adjoining property and would amount to spot soming.
- 3. The two-story frame dwelling where the Nursery would be carried on already houses two families and to load it up with 27 additional children would not only overcrowd it but would overtax the limited and inadequate plumbing facilities.

It is further determined that the present use of said remises as a Day Nursery is a violation of the Zoning Regulations and Restrictions and it is hereby ordered that said violation be terminated within ten (10) days from date hereof.

OPINION OF THE BOARD OF ZONING AFFEALS PALTIMORE COUNTY

This is an appeal by Armie D. Heath and Lillian M. Heath and Dorothy Ide Ziegler from an Order of the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County dated April 9, 1953, denying a special permit for a private school (Day Nursery) in regard to the property described in said petition.

The case came on for hearing before the Board, testimony was taken, and counsel heard.

The propert which is the subject of this petition is a tract of land in the Twelfth Election District of Baltimore County on the Southeast side of Brentwood Avenue, having a frontage of 75 feet thereon with a rectangular depth Southeasterly

There was some conflict in the testimony as to the need of a nursery school in this area, with some testifying that there is a need especially in view of the fact that their children attended the nursery; while others complained that there was not only no need, but the existence of such a school or nursery would be detrimental to the neighborhood and would depreciate their property.

There is some doubt in the mind of the Soard that the physical facilities of this nursery are adaptable for the use for which the appellants desire to use the same; and although some changes night be made to correct the inscioquate plumbing, this would not itself be sufficient corrective action as the record shows that there are at times two families living on the property and that an additional 15 children would be detrimental to the health, safety, and general welfare of the community; and, therefore, the Board will mass its Order denying the petition for a special permit.
