This is an appeal by William E. Weinreich from an Order of the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County dated June 1. 1953, granting a special permit for a contractor's storage yard in regard to the property described in the

The case came on for hearing before the Board, testimony was taken, and counsel heard.

The property which is the subject of this petition is located on the north side of Cypress Avenue in the Twelfth District of Baltimore County, having a frontage of 60 feet on said avenue by a depth of 100 feet.

Some of the witnesses testified that the granting of a special permit would be detrimental to the neighborhood and to property values, but it was noted that none of the owners adjoining the applicant's land, or across the street therefrom. objected to the property being used as a storage yard.
