This is an appeal from an Order of the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County dated November 3, 1953, denying an application for a special permit for an advertising atrusture in regard to the property described in the petition.

The case came on for hearing before the Board, testimony was taken, and counsel heard.

The property which is the subject for this special permit is located in a residential area. Under the soning regulations a special permit is required in any sone for a billiboard or advertising structure, and such permit "may be for an original period not exceeding two years, after which it may be renewed from year to year." The right for an advertising structure is not an absolute one, and from the testimony in this case and from examination of this property the Board is of a definite opinion that the granting of a special permit here would be detriental to the general welfurs of the community and should be denied.
