Subject of Petition: From A to F (Light Industrial) - S.s. of Joppa Road 1881.5: W. of Pleasant Plains Road

- 1. This request for light industrial rezoning of a portion of the Dadowood property is in line with the master planning for the foreon area, as it is being developed. The 25 acres of this petition are but a part of a larger traft of land (see sketch) which will in the near future be proposed by the Planning Commission for light industrial rezoning in conjunction with the Baltimore County Rezoning Project now
- 2. The basic reasoning which justifies the selection of a portion of the Eudowood property for future inquatrial use is outlined below.
 - a. Flat, cleared land, easily adapted for industrial development.
 - b. Close to excellent labor supply.
 - c. Good accessibility to major roads, some of which are yet in the planning stage but which will be constructed as the Tudowood property is built up.
 - d. Availability of both water and sever facilities. (Even though the sever capacity for the Herring Run drainage area - of which Eudowood is a part is presently limited in capacity, there probably will have to be provided in the future a parallel sever line to take care of the lands in the drainage area now vacant but proposed for eventual development. In this respect. the industrial development of the 25 acres of Eudowood is probably more consistent with the present restricted capacity of the Herring Run interceptor than if the 25 acres were to be developed for residential purposes.
 - e. Physical isolation from established or proposed neighborhoods as enviatoned in the master plan. Therefore there will be little, if any, disturbance caused by it with existing or new residential developments.

The location is in the vicinity of other industrial enterprises (Black & Decker, Murray Corp. & Bendik) which in combination with the Pleaning Conmission's industrial proposal for Dunewood, will comprise a incigatorbood of light industrial uses" adequately planned to offer a balanced community of residential, cornercial, and industrial uses for Towson.

3. Details of the sctual use of this property should be corelated with the proposed

- a. Stevenson Road, proposed to extend in a north-south direction between Jopps and Taylor Bonds cuts across a corner of this property. It therefore should be accounted for in the Bendiz development plan.
- b. A building setback or 100' 200' should be required at the restern Stevenson Road frontage since residential use will be made of the eastern frontage
- c. A maximum of two stories for any buildings might be established in keeping with the suburban setting of the troperty.
- d. It would be desirable to require that adequate treatment for both pedestrian and vehicular access between the two separate Bendix properties across Joppa Road from each other be provided in order to avoid congestion at this point
- . Off-street parking should be required.
- Because of the above details which must be coordinated it is recommended that the soning be granted subject to the approval of development plane by the Plannine Counterion for the items set forth.
