

The Plat attached to the Zoning Office file merely shows the perimeter outline of the property on which the nursing home is constructed.

In view of the wording of the Order of the Zoning Commissioner dated April 1, 1958 together with the information otherwise contained in the file, I feel that the grant of the special exception having been acted upon by the then operators of the nursing home and continuing from that day forward would entitle my clients, the successors in interest to the Foxleigh Nursing Home, Inc. to be able to expand their facility without the necessity of any further amendment to the existing grant of the special exception.
