This property and a large area of surrounding land are zoned N-L. The variance is requested to accemendate a small naminaturing use on a property thich is already complete by decling. Despite the industrial soming and the owner's aparent effort to make a transition to a use which suits the soning, we recommend against the requested variance.

Tendinary, emerically or two-family on lets of record before March 30, 1959, as regular practiced uses in the fact acc. (Sect. 253.4 of Balteriace County Zoning Repulations.) As regular permitted uses, such deciling should be pretented in a reasonable namer.
