> OPINION

The petitioner in 'his case seeks a special exception for a five car garage in the rear of 4105 Wilkens Avenue. The garage is to be used for the storage of motor vehicles used in connection with the funeral parlor operated by the petitioner at 4107 Wilkens Avenue, immediately adjacent to the subject property.

The petitioner testified that his vehicles are kept at three differenct locations at the present time. He also stated that no repairs or lubrication work would be done on the premises: no maintenence other than the washing and waxing of the cars.

The funeral parlor at 4107 Wilkens Avenue was established approximately five years ago with the first floor and basement used for business purposes and the second floor used as living quarters for the petitioner and his family. Mr. Hubbard acquired the adjoining property at 5105 Wilkens Avenue in May, 1958, and, after alterations are completed, plans to occupy it as a residence and use \$107 exclusively

The protestants, who reside at 1009 Wilkens Avenue, testified that, in their coinion, the granting of this special exception would increase the traffic of funeral vehicles and would create a traffic hazard on Wilkens Avenue. The petitioner contended that there would be less wehicular movement in and out of the property if all of the care were stored on the premises.
