## ............. OPINION

This is a petition for a special exception for the erection of an advertising structure (billboard) on property owned by the Baltimore & Chio Railroad Company and adjoining their right-of-way. Donnelly Advertising Corporation of Maryland is the lessee of the subject property, which is presently zoned Business Local.

It was testified that the advertising sign would be approximately 12 feet by 25 feet in area and would be 8 feet above the ground. The sign would rise approximately 2 feet above the roof of a

Second Avenue does not intersect Hammonds Ferry Road at this point because of the railroad tracks. The proposed advertising structure will be placed on vacant land lying between Hammonds Ferry Road and the tracks, and would be visible only to traffic going west on Hammonds Ferry Road.

The Roard is of the oninion that the plans for the structure, as submitted by the potitioner, meet all the requirements of Sections 13.3 and 13.5 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and will not violate any of the provisions of Section 502.1.

For the above reasons, the special exception asked for to granted, subject to the restriction that any illumination of the sign shall be so located and arranged as to avoid glare or reflection into the path of encoming vehicles on Second Avenue approaching Hammonds Ferry Road.

For the reasons set forth in the aforegoing opinion, it is this 28th day of May, 1959, by the County Board of Appeals, ORDERED that the special exception petitioned for be and the same is hereby granted, subject, however, to the restriction set forth in the above opinion. Any appeal fronthis decision must be in accordance with
