The petitioners herein apply for a special exception to operate a Day Nursery in their home, located on the north side of Eddlynch Road, approximately 500 feet west of Lynch Road in the 12th District. The house is a one story brick structure located on a lot 73 feet wide and 380 feet deep. The room to be used for Day Nursery purposes is in a newly constructed addition to the rear of the house. The home is occupied by the petitioners and their two children.

The owners of the homes on either side of the subject property stated that they had no objections to the projected Day Nursery. Several other residents in the neighborhood testified in favor of the petition. A group of residents and a spokesman for the Kingdon Hall of Jebovah's Witness who have a place of worship in the area objected to the proposed Day Nursery primarily on the grounds that it would increase traffic on Eddlynch Road and further, that it would constitute commercial encroach-

Testimony and photographs submitted at the hearing indicated that there was very little traffic on Eddlynch Road at the present time. It was also testified that the rear of a large supermarket was across the street from the subject property. It was also stated that a large department store had recently opened a short distance away.
