

HOUSING DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY
PERMIT FOR SPECIAL EXCEPTION
BY RESOLUTION

Pursuant to petition and with the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County, the following Special Exception for the proposed use of the property owned by the Baltimore Herald-Examiner Publishing Corporation, the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County and the Board of Zoning Appeals and Regulations of Baltimore County, a public hearing was held at the County Courthouse, Baltimore, Maryland, at the County Office Building, 111 N. Calverton Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, on the 14th day of February, 1943, at 10:00 A. M.

To determine whether or not the Special Exception should be granted, it was determined that the following facts should be noted: That the proposed use of the property is a newspaper publishing plant previously described as follows:

All that parcel of land in the Eighth District of Baltimore County, Maryland, bounded on the north by the Baltimore and Annapolis Railroad, on the east by the side of York Road, beginning 1900 feet from the intersection of York Road and the Baltimore and Annapolis Railroad, and extending easterly along the side of York Road, ending 1900 feet from the place of the intersection of York Road and the Baltimore and Annapolis Railroad, containing approximately 100 feet by 100 feet.

That said parcel is within the Zoning Department of Baltimore County, Maryland.
