Dear Mr. Kotroco:

This request is to confirm that proposed new mausoleum buildings to be constructed on this existing cemetery property are accessory buildings, subject to the requirements of Section 400, BCZR and do not require minimum setbacks between mausoleum buildings and that the proposed mausoleum construction is within the Spirit and Intent of the previous zoning case.

The cemetery property is approximately 75 acres in area and zoned RC-4. The cemetery was granted a Special Exception in Case No. 5215-XA. The Order in that Case approved a cemetery on this site with two conditions: 1) that all plans for ingress and egress be approved by the Office of Planning and Zoning and; 2) that the first 100 feet adjacent to Berrymans Lane not be used for any grave sites.

The proposed mausoleum buildings meet the zoning requirements for accessory buildings. They will be located in the rear yard (i.e, beyond the front yard setback of 100 feet established in Case No. 5215-XA), they will be located more than 2½ feet from any property line and the height will not exceed 15 feet. The enclosed plan indicates that the area proposed for mausoleum construction is in the rear yard, a minimum of 690 feet from the front property line and a minimum of 260 feet from the closest side property line. The front of the property is at Berryman's Lane.

The proposal also meets the conditions of Zoning Case 5215-XA. No grave sites or mausoleums are proposed within 100 feet of Berrymans Lane and no changes are proposed to the existing ingress and egress, which is from Berryman's Lane.

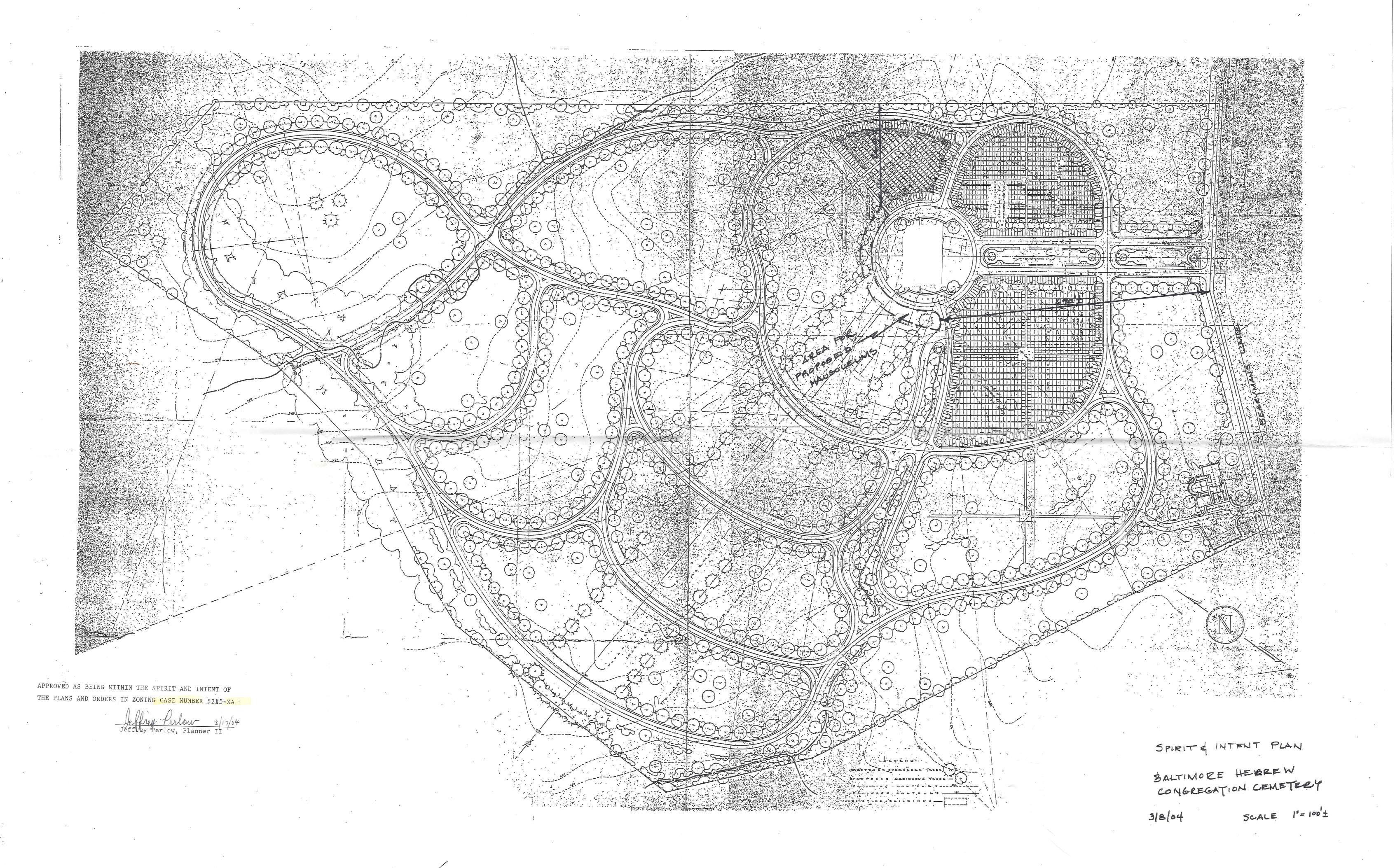
Spirit and Intent Plan

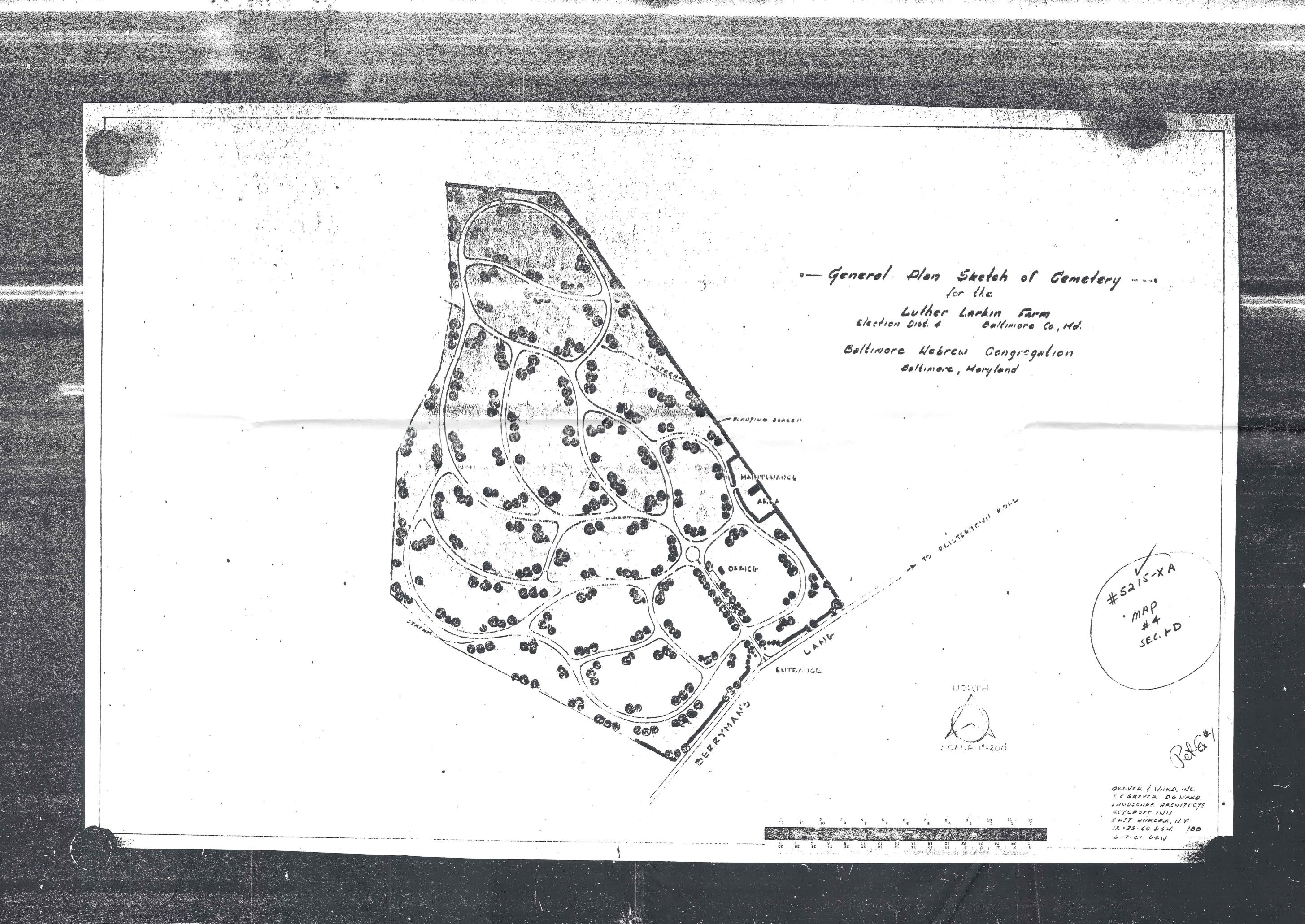
Site Plan, Case No. 5215-XA

This is a petition for a Special Exception for a Cometery and Chapel on property located on Borryman's Lane, 2500 feet West of Roj terstown Road in the 4th District of Baltimore County. The total area covered by the special exception is 60 acres more or less. The property has a frontage of 1100 feet on Berryman's Lane.

restimony was presented by Mr. Eli H. Pinerman, Ex Director of the Baltimore Hebrew Congregation, that it was the feeling of this referred Jewish Congregation, that there was a need for a cemetery in the northwest area of the greater Baltimore area. The explanation of this pred was, that the congregation's Temple had moved from the location on Madison Avenue in Baltimore City to a location at Slade Avenue and Park Heights Avenue, this property being located partially inHaltimore City and partially in Baltimore County. Since 1951, the congregation has grown from 650 families to a size now greater than 1550 families. Mr. Pinerman further testified that a caretaker would live on the presise, and that the cemetery would be operated and maintained so as to cause no unsightly pikes of dirt, trash or rubbish to accumulate. Mr. Pinerman further testified that during the past 10 years, the congregation had averaged 75 burials per year, and that during a three month period from May 3, 1961 to July 19, 1961, that a total of 156 vehicles had entered the censtery for 14 different burials; average of 11 cars per burial. He further testified that the maximum number of cars in any one of these burials was 20.

the Board also heard from Mr. Malcolm Sherman, a licer Realter who has been handling Real Estate exclusively in the northwest of Baltimore mince 1951. He testified that 65 homes could be built on this property at the present time under M-40 classification, and that these homes would produce approximately 100 cars plus the various delivery ssary for servicing these 65 homes.

Mr. Bernard willemain, a qualified expert Planner, testified that in his opinion the use of the subject property for a cemetery was a masonable use of the land and stated that in his opinion, modern day ries pose no problems for adjoining property owners. He cited the various building developments such as; Epringlake and the present development of the Parks property, where homes in the \$30,000 area are being built-both of these developments located in the invediate area of the Dulancy Memorial Gardens Cemetery.

The poard is unenimous in its opinion that the granting of the special exception requested in this petition would in no way violate the provisions of Section 502.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations We cannot see where it would be detrimental in any way to the health, safety or general welfare of the locality involved. We should also like to point out that the protestants themselves, all of whom, own property or reside in this general area, stated that in their opinion this petit on would have no effect on the health, safety or welfare of the community, other than the problem of traffic. The Board has considered the traffic problem and cannot possibly see ho. a cemetery could produce any greater traffic than would be produced if the property were to be developed with

For the above reasons, this petition for special exception is unanimously granted subject to the following restrictions:

- a. All plans for ingress and egress must be approved by the Office of Planning and Zoning of Baltimore
- b. I first 100 feet adjacent to Berryman's Land

- Subject to compliance with the six conditions listed in Section 502.1 for special exceptions, this office values no real ob-terior conditions to the capability of berryman's least in the present condition to handle large security of new truffle. It would appear that the putitioner should specifically show that the proposed cemetory will not tend to create congestion or undue truffle hasacts on Berryman's lane.

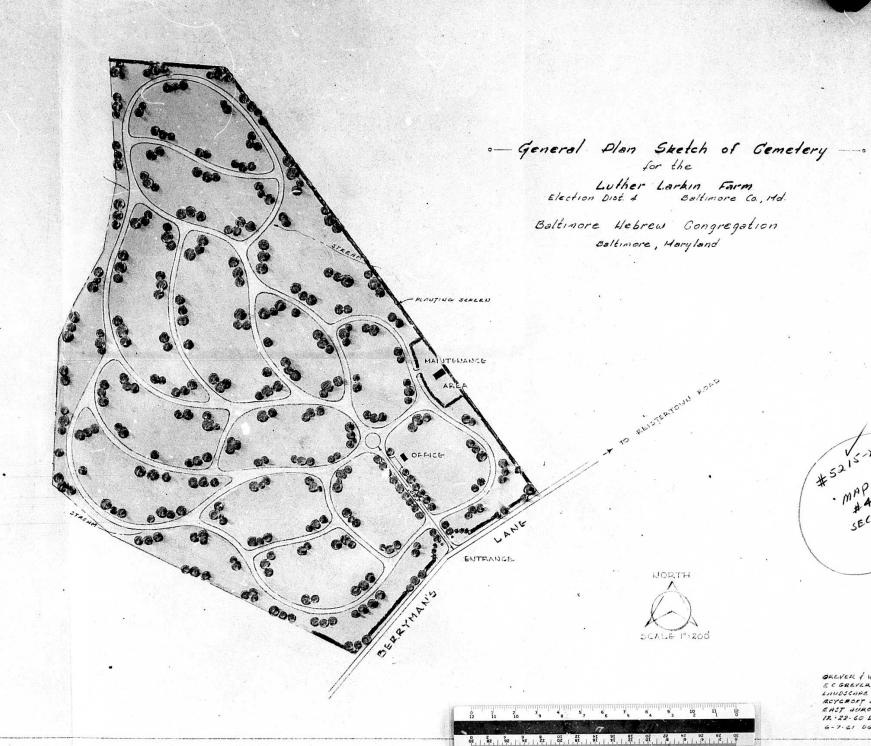
