OPINION

This is a petition for a special exception for a gasoline service station on property located on the southeast corner of Church Lane and proposed Hendon Road in the Second District of Baltimore County.

Mr. Gilbert M. Nelson, Acting Chief of the Traffic and Planning Division of Baltimore County, was the first witness for the petitioner. His testimony was to the effect that the granting of this special exception for a gasoline service station was not desirva le as Church Lane in its present condition is inadequate, and that any additional ingress or egress to or from Church Lane, or any additional traffic on Church Lane would be highly undesirable at this time. At the conclusion of Mr. Nelson's testimony, the attorney for the petitioner was asked by the Board if he had any other witnesses to present to the Board who would be testifying on the matter of traffic. He advised the Board that he would not present any additional testimony on the subject of traffic. The Board advised the petitioner that it was unanimous in its opinion that the testimony presented by the petitioner's traffic expert clearly indicated that Section 502.1, Paragraphs A and B, could not be complied with and that for this reason the Board was denying the special exception.

For the reasons set forth in the aforegoing Opinion, it is this 15 Th of April, 1963 by the County Board of Appeals, ORDERED that the special exception petitioned for, be and the same is heraby denied.

Any appeal from this decision must be in accordance with Chapter 1100, subtitle B of Maryland Rules of Procedure, 1961 edition.
