This is a petition for special exception for a gasotine service station on the southeast side of Cresson Avenue and the northwest side of Windsor Mill Road in the Second District of Baltimore County.

This property was zoned "B-L" by the County Council at the time of the adoption of the Second District land use map on November 15, 1962. The property actually is on the northeast corner of Windsor Mill Road and Cresson Avenue and is a part of land owned by the petitioner. In addition to the subject property, petitioner also owns additional frontage to the east of approximately fifty feet on Windsor Mill Road and to the north, a small strip of "B-L" land approximately ten feet wide. Contiguous to this small strip of business local land he owns approximately 125 feet of "R-A" land.

The Board cannot help being cognizant of the uses which are now permitted under a business local classification without an additional zoning hearing. Considering that the Board can and is writing restrictions on the use of the property, which restrictions we believe give the necessary protection needed by surrounding properties, one can only believe that the use of the subject property under these restrictions will be far more compatible to surrounding property owners than any of the unrestricted uses presently permitted in the "B-L" classification.

It is, therefore, the unanimous opinion of the Board of Appeals that the special exception be granted subject to the following restrictions:

- Ingress and egress to the subject station be confined to Windsor Mill Road; that there be no ingress or egress of any kind on Cresson Avenue
- That the rest rooms for men and women be located on the eastern side of the subject building, and that there be no doorways or entrances into the building on the western
