 When we were there, there were four or five children at the
 time we were there and I was in company with Inspector Edward
 Kinsel of the Fire Prevention Bureau. We made an inspection

 another recommendation was to fireproof ceiling with fire
 resisting material to meet building code, install hand rail on
 basement steps to outside and a few other minor things. My
