OPINION

This is an appeal from a Special Hearing by the Zoning Commissioner to determine whether or not the Zoning Commissioner should approve application for a building permit to permit the storage and sale of gasoline for marine purposes on the subject property. The Zoning Commissioner had such a hearing and by his Order dated March 3, 1964 granted the petitioner the right to apply for a building permit to stere and sell

By Order of the Board of Appeals dated January 8, 1958, Case No.4019-X, the previous owners of the property were granted a special exception to use the property as a boat yard. In granting the special exception the Board imposed certain restrictions; paragraph three of the restrictions states;

The handling of supplies, excluding gasoline, is permitted, provided all activity involving use of such supplies shall be housed in a building constructed, if

The petitioner in this case wishes to have this restriction lifted so that he can store and sell gaseline on the subject property in connection with his boat yard.

The petitioner here, Joseph A. Blazek, testified that he has had numerous requests for gasoline sales; that all of the other boat yard owners in the area sell gasoline; that he would lose his customers because he is unable to sell gas.

There was ample testimony by the petitioners' witnesses that there would not be any violation of Section 502,1 of the Zoning Regulations, including testimony as to Section 502.1 (a) and (c) from the petitioner.

Further testimony from Mr. Robert Strausbury was that it would not have any

effect upon traffic conditions, and that it would generally be a benefit rather than a detriment to the community.

The Board was particularly impressed by the testimony of Mr. Edwin J. Schamel, who lives approximately 100 feet from the pier in question, and who testified that the gas pumps would not hurt his property and that he had no objection to the Blazek's

Mr. Wickert, a next door neighbor south of the subject property, testified that he did object as he felt the spillage of gas might contaminate the water. However, there was no showing by anyone that more or less gasoline would be spilled by using storage and pump facilities rather than filling the boat tanks by cans. He also stated that there is no gasoline odor amanated by gas pumps. He proposed the only testimony regarding any possible traffic congestion in that he felt that Shore Road is now congested and that large tank trucks would not be able to maneuver sufficiently on it. However, from all of the testimony produced it is apparent that the boat yard would not take gas delivery more than once a week and in all probability not more than once a month. Therefore, the Board is not persuaded that this would create any congestion in the roads or streets in violation of Section 502.1, subsection b.

It is also persuasive to the Board that in light of the present Zoning Regulations as embodied in County Council Bill No. 64 dated August 12, 1963 wherein the storage and sale of gasoline at boat yards is a permitted use, that the Order of the Board of Appeals dated January 8, 1958 should be modified so as to permit underground storage and sale of boat fuel, and maintenance of fueling facilities in conjunction with the use of the property subject, of course, to the regulations of the various departments of the County concerned with issuing permits.

For the reasons stated above the Order of the Zoning Commissioner dated March 3, 1964 is affirmed by the County Board of Appeals.




