This letter is for the purpose of supplying some details associated with the subject special exception.

Special Exception No. 65-207-X is for the erection of a free atanding non-guyed steel pole to support a three-element 14 megacycle per second and 21 mc per second directional antenna. The antenna and antenna pole are to be used in the Amateur Radio Service

The Amateur Radar Service is regulated by the United States Government and is a non-commercial communication service as defined in the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission Fart 97.

The Federal Communications Commission has issued a license for the operation of anateur radio station (NIEC at 2113 Southland Boad, Bullance, Maryland 2197). This station is licensed in the manual of the commission of the license is ADVANCO. This license became effective August 6, 1986, and expires Aumany 23, 1987.

The license is subject to the right of use or control by the government of the United States under section 606 of the Commun ications Act of 1934, as amended.

All authority granted by the license is required to be exercised in accordance with the provisions of all treaties, laws, orders, rules and regulations that apply to anature radio operators and anature radio stations licensed by the Commission. Enclosed with this letter are some excepts from the Covernment Rules and Regulations.

The rules and regulations in this part are designed to provide an amateur radio service having a fundamental purpose as expressed in the following principles:

(a) Recognition and enhancement of the value of the austeur service to the public as a voluntary non-conner communication service, particularly with respect to pro-viding emergency communications.

(b) Continuation and extension of the amateur's proven ability to contribute to the alvancement of the radio art.

(c) Encouragement and improvement of the amateur radio service through rules which provide for ad-aneing shills in both the communication and technical phases of the art.

(d) Expansion of the existing reservoir within the anateur ervice of trained operators, technicians nics experts.

(e) Continuation and extension of the amateur's unique ability to enhance international good will.

97.3 Amateur Operator

(b) The term "amateur operator" means a person interested in radio technique solely with a personal aim and without pecuniary interest, holding a valid license issued by the name and the control of the control of the control of the licensed ashieur stations.

97.3 (f) Amateur Radio Communication

The term "anateur radio communication" means undio communi-cation between anateur stations solely with a personal aim and without pecuniary interest.
