The staff of the Office of Planning and Zoning has reviewed the subject petition for a Variance to the maximum height permitted for a sign. It has the following Advisory comments to make with respect to pertinent planning factors:

Again, we question the allogations of practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship which could justify the variance being sought. The Zoning Regulations created two categories of signs - business signs and outdoor advertising signs. Bot of these categories established standards which are in fact the spirit and intent of the Zoning Regulations. From a Planning viewpoint, granting the subject variance for height would represent a gross departure from the standards and requirements of the Regulations. A variance here would make the Regulations meaningless.
