As you probably know, the special exception was
granted by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner and on July 26,

community associations.

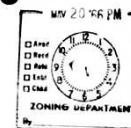
My home address is 6404 Pinhurst Road, which faces York Road.

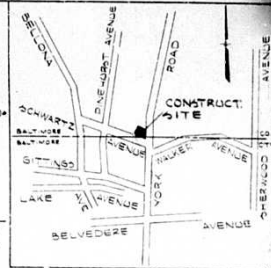
