Review of the subject plat dated Rovember 1905 results in the following comments:

On the other hand, if the subject site is zoned for apartments, the area will gener-ate 17,470 trips per day.

Rolling Road now sxists as a two lane road with a capacity of 9000 vehicles per day. The ultimate plan for Rolling Road is four lanes undivided with a capacity of 18,000 vehicles per day.

The apartment site will generate 1820 trips per day existing zoning can be expected to generate 150 trips
