#### BRIEF ACCOMPANYING PETITION

The Petitioners, Stephen R. Brown and Irene Brown, by Philip O. Tilghman, their attorney, respectfully state:

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. The Petitioners are the owners of a tract of land fronting on the north side of German Hill Road between 51st Street and 50th Street, being on the northwest corner of Germa Hill Road and 51st Street and fronting on German Hill Road 140.05 feet and with a depth along 51st Street of 194.70 feet. The entire frontage of this lot has a depth of 194.70 feet, except for the westernmost 25 feet which has a depth of 125 feet
- 2 The entire frontage on German Hill Road between 50th and 51st Streets, including a part of this lot, is zoned Bt. for a depth of 115 feet northerly from the centerline of German Hill Road. The remaining portion of the Petitioners lot, north of the BL zoning is zoned DR 5.5.
- 3. The entire frontage of the opposite side of German Hill Road, that is the south side between 50th and 51st Streets, is also zoned BL, but for a depth of 145 feet from the center of German Hill Road. Thus the property on the opposite side of

the street is zoned BL for an additional depth of 30 feet.

- 4. The northeast corner of German Hill Road and 51st Street is also zoned BL, but that is zoned BL for a depth of 165 feet, or for a depth of 50 feet more than the Petitioners' property
- 5. The Petitioners are requesting that the aforesaid rear portion of their lot be zoned BL instead of DR 5.5 so that the zoning on the rear portion would conform to the BL zoning on the front portion. The Petitioners are also requesting a variance to obtain a zero feet side yard for the building proposed at the west side of their lot.

#### REASONS FOR PETITIONERS' REQUEST

The Petitioners' position is that it was an error in the map not to zone their entire lot BL, rather than just the front portion, and among the reasons therefor are the following:

1. That the depth of the BL zoning on their lot is inadequate and insufficient for proper utilization of same for BL permitted uses; and likewise the remaining rear portion of their lot which is zoned DR 5.5 cannot properly and efficiently be utilized under DR 5.5 zoning classification. This is indicated by the fact that on the map the south side of German Hill zoned BL to a depth of 145 feet and the north side of German Hill Road at the northeast corner of German Hill and 51st Street the BL zoning extends to a depth of 165 feet. This indicates a recognition of the fact that a depth of 115 feet from

2. Traffic hazards and parking problems would be eliminated if the depth of the BL zoning was deeper to allow the buildings to set farther back from the road and thus allow better parking area between the buildings and the front street; and would allow better visibility for traffic on German Hill Road and 51st Street and create more feasible conditions for an easy flow of traffic on and off the subject property.

3. Since the Petitioners' lot is a small lot, the BL zoning should have conformed to the lot lines rather than arbitrarily divide this small lot into two small parcels having incompatible uses.

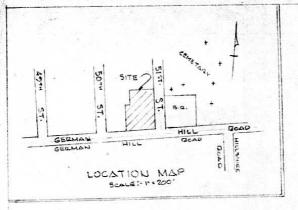

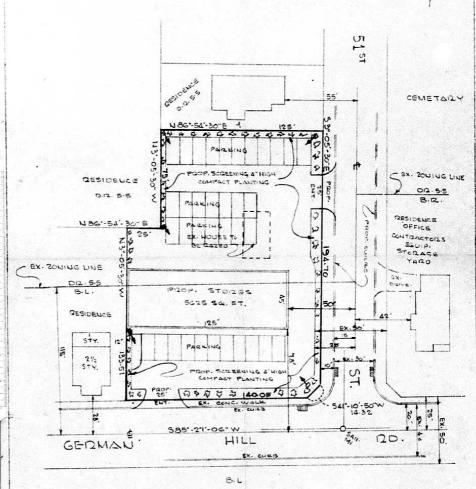

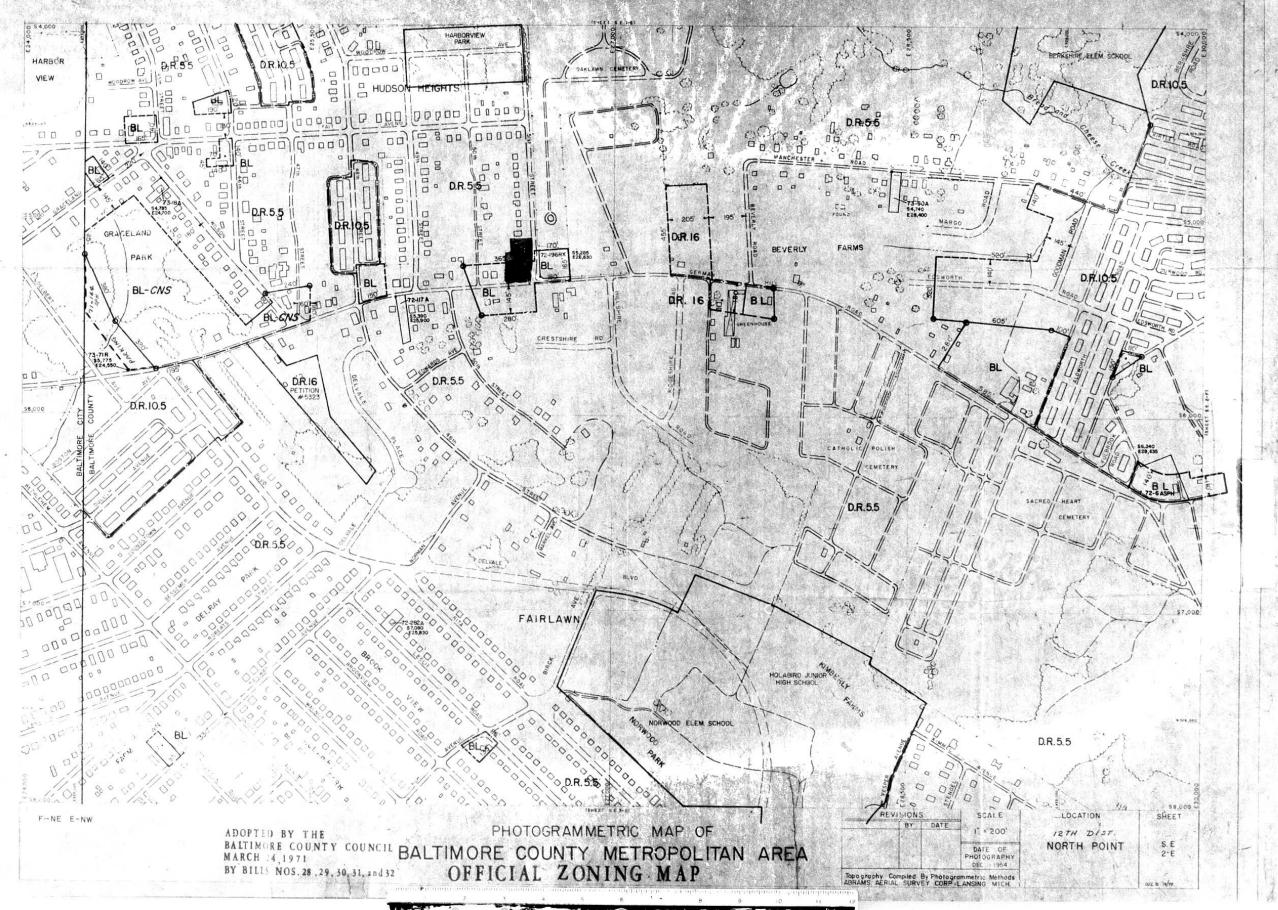
