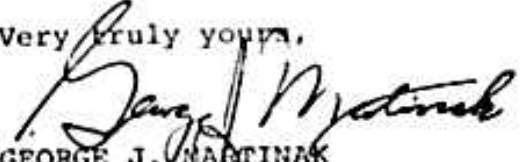
Dear Mr. Cline:

As indicated in your letter of November 10, 1977, the above referenced property was granted a Special Exception for office use (Case #77-162-X) with the restriction that it be utilized for a travel agency only. Subsequent to this, a Special Hearing (Case #77-184-SPH) was requested and granted removing the above restriction.

A review of the site plan submitted with the latter case indicates that the entire building, encompassing 1,296 square feet, can be converted to general or medical offices as long as adequate parking is provided.
