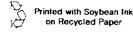

In response to your letter dated September 3, 1991 please be advised that Society Mortgage foreclosed on their construction loan and that NewLife is no longer defending lawsuits brought by suppliers/subcontractors.

NewLife now finds itself insolvent with substantial accounts and trade creditors owed in excess of \$1,500,000. Since the beginning of 1990 virtually all of NewLife's employees have left the company or been terminated. Its only assets are some office furniture in storage in Baltimore.

Obviously, under these circumstances we cannot expect you to expend any more money on the swimming pool appeal. By copy of this letter to Bill Sawers at MBA I am sending him a copy of your letter dated September 3, 1991.

I have been retained as legal counsel to Mr. Alonzo Corley, who resides at 52 Nakota Court, Middle River, Maryland, 21220 which is part of the Golden Brook Townhomes, a development of the Village of Pawnee Limited Partnership.

The Petitioner has requested a Special Hearing to approve the 4th Amended Partial Development Plan for Section 111, Village Pawnee, which proposes a community swimming pool and bathhouse to be located at a site which is in close proximity to Mr. Corley's townhome. Mr. Corley is strongly opposed to this proposal and request that the Petitioner's request be denied.

Mr. Corley contracted to purchase his Golden Brook Townhome in the Village of Pawnee on May 5, 1989 and settled on the property on February 14, 1990. In entering into this contract of sale for said property, Mr. Corley relied on the representations of the sales agent, as well as the sign placed on the property, that the swimming pool was to be located near the entrance of the development, a location removed from Mr. Corley's townhome. In addition, the sales representative and apparent agent for the Petitioner, Ms. Irene Spicer, assured Mr. Corley that not only would the pool not be located near his home, the property adjacent to his home was designated open land.

No indication was ever made to Mr. Corley that the pool would be located anywhere but the entrance of the development. While it is unfortunate that the developers of this project did not first obtain approval of the original site for the swimming pool before beginning their sales effort, there is no rational basis for punishing Mr. Corley by approving this request to amend the partial development plan. Mr. Corley bargained with the developers in good faith, expecting that they would fulfill their end of the bargain in a like manner. However, if the developers had knowledge of the fact that the original site for the swimming pool would not or could not be approved by Baltimore County yet nonetheless proceeded to market the townhomes to prospective buyers, such as Mr. Corley, then it might appear they acted in bad faith.

He expected a quiet, open space in which to live and is now face with the prospect of a noisy, high traffic environment. 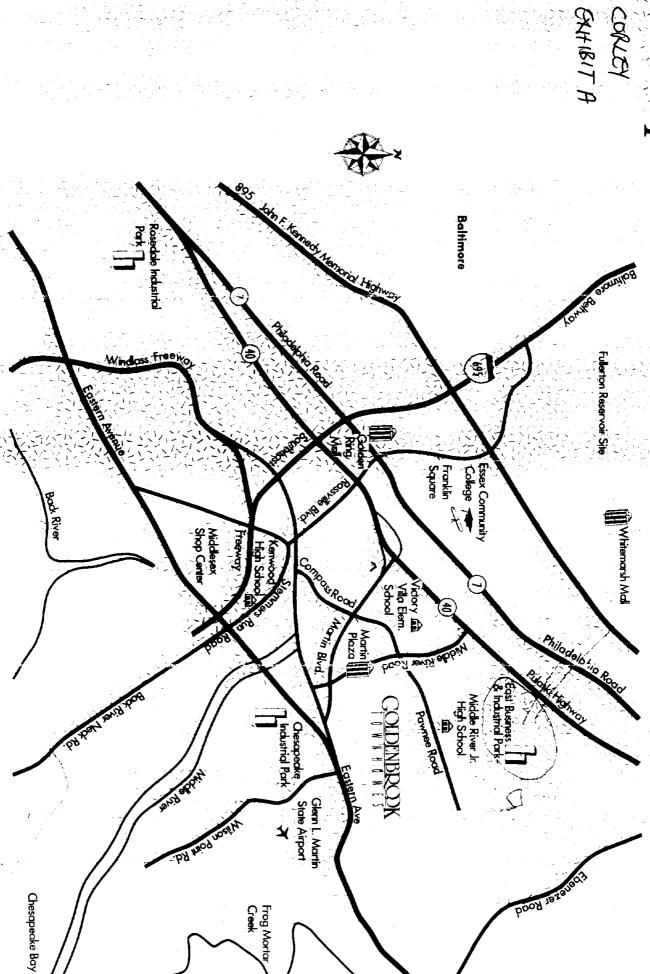

### \*\*\*\*\*\* FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Petitioner herein, pursuant to the Petition for Special Hearing, requests the approval of the 4th Amended Partial Development Plan for Section III, Village of Pawnee, which proposes a community swimming pool and bathhouse to be owned by the Homeowners Association in lieu of eleven (11) townhouses and Choctaw Court, as more particularly described on Petitioner's Exhibits No. 1 and 6.

The Petitioner, by Will Duvall and Bill D. Jones, appeared, testified and was represented by J. Carroll Holzer. Esquire. Appearing as an interested party on behalf of the Petition was Steve Gabbiret. Appearing and testifying as a Protestant was Alonzo C. Corley, Jr., and represented by David Shapiro, Esquire. Mr. Shapiro sent a letter to the Commissioner dated October 11, 1990 (Protestant's Exhibit No. A) indicating his client's position relative to the placement of the swimming pool, (Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1) and also requesting postponement of the hearing in this case which was October 17, 1990. The request for postponement was denied.

The Petitioner is the current owner of a development known as the Village of Pawnee which is located in the southeastern section of Baltimore County. The property consists of approximately 67 +/- acres with various mixed zoning classifications including most of the D.R. zones and some

M.L.R. zone. The particular portion of this development in question in this hearing is Section III which is shown on sheet 2 of 3 of the Development Plan and is marked Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1. Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1 also represents a high lighted and colored version of the proposed changes which would become the 4th amended partial development plan for Section III of the Village of Pawnee. Petitioner's Exhibit No. 2 is a copy of the entire Village of Pawnee plan showing the various sections and Section III is a section of townhomes roughly located in the center of the development

The Petitioner's predecessors in title had originally proposed placing a community building and community pool in Section IV of the Village of Pawnee and that relief was denied in an earlier case before the Zoning Commissioner. According to the Petitioner's attorney, through proffered testimony, the Petitioner, after obtaining title to the development, decided to relocate the community pool to a location that would be large enough to support the operation without requiring.

Pursuant to Section 1B01.3.A.7.c. the Petitioner may amend a partial development plan. Approval to remove the originally designated housing units to allow for the development of a community recreational activity such as the proposed community pool may be requested by a developer. Pursuant to the legislation, all those homeowners who live within 300 ft. of the proposed change must either agree to the proposed change or a public hearing before the Zoning Commissioner will be required to determine whether or not the proposed change is consistent with the spirit and intent of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) and consistent with the development project in question. As shown on Petitioner's Exhibit No. 3,  $\widetilde{\mathbf{C}}$   $\overset{\circ}{\odot}$  the area proposed for amendment was originally to be developed with two

rows of townhomes which has been replaced with one row of townhomes and the proposed community pool and associated parking facilities. Petitioner's Exhibit No. 4 is an overlay which shows the approximate layout of the community pool over the area which was originally designated for additional Petitioner's Exhibit No. 6 clearly sets forth the approval of most of the adjoining landowners within 300 ft. of the proposed change except for the Protestant. The public hearing on this matter was held on October 17, 1990 in compliance with requirements of B.C.Z.R.

The Petitioner's witnesses testified that the proposed swimming pool would be a community pool operated by the Homeowner's Association and the membership would be restricted to the owners of the Village of Pawnee. Furthermore, the Petitioner's witnesses testified that the right to membership is inherent with the ownership of a home in the development and that the pool operation would be a community pool operation consistent with the regulations, policies and procedures of the Baltimore County Zoning Office for a community pool facility.

The Petitioner's witnesses testified in detail as to the proposed pool operation with accessory bathhouse. The pool has been sized in accordance with the regulations of the Baltimore County Department of Health. Furthermore, provisions for appropriate offsite parking has been provided in the area dedicated for the proposed community pool. Unlike the previous community pool request, there will be no community building at this location, only a bathhouse and associated facilities necessary for the operation of the pool. As shown on Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1, a detailed landscaping plan has been developed for the pool operation and the pool will be appropriately fenced and all exterior lighting will be extinguished or designed to prevent any lighting from being shown onto residential properties. The

Petitioner's witnesses testified that the parking lot would be chained closed during the months when the community pool is not in operation and that the parking lot would not be used for the storage of boats or recreational vehicles.

The Petitioner's witnesses testified that the proposed pool had been approved as shown on Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1 by the Baltimore County Planning Board and that the pool is a vital part of the development of this particular community.

The Petitioner's witnesses testified that, based on their professional experience, it was their opinion that the community pool would not cause any adverse impact and would not create traffic congestion over and above what already exists. He testified that the conditions delineated in Section 502.1 (B.C.Z.R.) will be satisfied.

Mr. Duvall testified that, in his opinion, the proposed use at the subject property would not be detrimental to the health, safety, and general welfare of the community, and that the conditions delineated in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. will be satisfied.

Mr. Alonzo Corley, Jr. testified extensively to his opposition to the proposed location of the pool. Mr. Corley, clearly and succinctly, argued his position that the proposed pool was originally marketed to be located within Section IV at the location previously denied in an earlier hearing. He believes that it is unfair and a violation of his contractual rights to now relocate the pool closer to his residential unit which is located at the end of a row of homes on Nakota Court. Mr. Corley, using Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1, showed the relative distance from the proposed community pool to his home. He testified at length to his belief that the overcrowding of this community facility and the noise and light that emanates there-

from will have an adverse impact upon his quiet enjoyment of his property. Also, Mr. Corley testified that he believes the community pool will reduce the value of his residential unit and that the Petitioner has breached his contract with him concerning the location of this pool. His arguments are clearly set forth in Protestant's Exhibit No. A and need not be reprinted at length in this opinion. Exhibit A is a part of the permanent record of this file.

The Protestant's arguments and claims concerning breach of contract and bad faith simply are not issues within the jurisdiction of the Baltimore County Zoning Commissioner. As discussed during the hearing on this matter, the Zoning Commissioner is not empowered to review contract disputes between the parties. That jurisdiction lies with the Baltimore County Circuit Court and, therefore, the impact of these particular issues is not germane to the decision before the Zoning Commissioner.

The issue herein is whether or not the proposal as set forth on Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1 for the 4th amended partial development plan for Section III of the Village of Pawnee is consistent with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, the Zoning Commissioner must determine whether a particular land use produces an adverse impact above and beyond that inherently associated with that use within the community where it is proposed and, furthermore, that the proposal is not detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the locality in ques-

Clearly, the B.C.Z.R. envision community recreational facilities in the D.R. zones. Furthermore, the proposed residential development of the Village of Pawnee is consistent with the land uses envisioned in the D.R. regulations and the community pool facility as proposed on Petitioner's

Exhibit No. 1 is an acceptable land use in conjunction with the development of an integrated residential community. The proposal clearly fits upon the land dedicated for this use as no variances are required in order to allow an appropriately sized facility to exist on the property in question. There is sufficient area to provide both vegetative screen buffering and appropriate fencing for safety purposes.

The proposal is being developed in a manner consistent with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R. and the Zoning Commissioner's policies concerning community pools. After reviewing all of the testimony and evidence presented, it appears that the request set forth in the special hearing should be granted with certain restrictions as much fully described below in order to safeguard the quiet enjoyment of the residential properties adjacent to the proposed community pool.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons given above, the special hearing relief should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County this 18 day of December 1990, that, pursuant to the Petition for Special Hearing, approval of the 4th Amended Partial Development Plan for Section III, Village of Pawnee, which proposes a community swimming pool and bathhouse to be owned by the Home Owners Association in lieu of eleven (11) townhouses and Choctaw Court, is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the restrictions set forth below which are conditions precedent to the relief granted herein:

> 1. The Petitioner may apply for its building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk

until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original

2. When applying for a building permit, the site plan and landscaping plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

3. All parking lot lighting shall be no more than 10 feet above-grade. All exterior lighting shall be directed downward and shall not diffuse onto any residential property.

4. The parking lot for the community pool shall not be used for overnight storage of recreational vehicles and/or boats and commercial or recreational trailers of any type. The parking lot for the community pool shall not be used for the overnight storage of any damaged or disabled motor vehicle of any type.

5. The Petitioner shall not allow the operation of this community pool before May 20th or after September 15th of any calendar year. The parking lot shall be chained closed and maintained in a vacant state from September 15th through May 20th in each and every calendar year except for visits for ordinary maintenance and repair of the community pool facilities.

6. Upon request and reasonable notice, the Petitioner shall permit a representative of the Zoning Enforcement Division to make an inspection of the subject property to insure compliance with this Order.

7. The Petitioner shall have no outside paging

8. The proposed facilities for the community pool shall not begin operation prior to 9:00 A.M. and shall cease all such operation no later than 9:00 p.m.

9. The Petitioner shall provide a landscape plan to the Office of Current Planning for approval by the Baltimore County Landscape Planner and said landscape plan shall then be submitted to the Zoning Commissioner for approval. The approved landscape plan shall

become a permanent part of the record and file in this matter.

10. The pool shall be operated as a community pool and not a commercial recreational facility. The community pool shall be opened for membership to only those individuals and the family members of those individuals who are property owners within the Village of Pawnee.

11. The Petitioner shall erect a privacy screening fence in the location and of a type and material to be determined by the Baltimore County Landscape Planner that will affectively screen the community pool from adjacent residential properties and which will adequately provide for the safety of all of the citizens of Baltimore County consistent with the requirements of the Baltimore County Department of Permits and Licenses and the Health Department.
