This case comes before this Board on a Petition for Beclassification from D.B. 5.5 to B.L. after being denied by the Roard of Appeals in 1986 on an open site plan and in the Comprehensive Zoning Map Process of 1988. The subject property is located at the corner of Soth Avenue and Relair Boad in the Sixth Councilmanic District of Baltimore County.

The petition had been timely filed with the Board of Appeals for a public hearing on August 6, 1991 as a Documented Site Plan. That hearing was then suspended preliminary to the resubmission of the documented plan with recommended amendments to the Plannin Board to assure compliance with that body's July 18, 1991 recommendations. The petition for a documented site plan in a B.L. zone was then heard in its entirety on this day, February 18, 1992.

Counsel for the Petitioner presented Mr. Thomas Phelps. registered surveyor and person responsible for the plan for the subject site as reviewed by the Planning Board. The .16-acre parcel is a level, vacant property that was originally purchased in 1986 by Petitioner as a location for a brick, one-story office building designed to bland with area residences. Testimony by Mr Phelps reviewed the parking, the landscaping of the property,

Petitioner, Mr. Carmelo DiPorte, testified to his long career as a barber and recent desire to relocate his barbershop to a site more convenient to his customers. Petitioner reviewed his perceptions of traffic on Belair Road and its effect on residential properties fronting the major interstate highway.

Mr. DiForte reflected that the Comprehensive Map Process of 1988 should have recognized the disadvantages for residential properties on Belair Road, particularly with the projected widening of the heavily-travelled highway. Acknowledging that his requested B.L. zone in 1988 could have allowed various business uses on the site. Petitioner is satisfied to be limited by the terms of the Documented Site Plan offering him no alternatives.

In response to People's Counsel, Mr. DiForte concurred that zoning along Belair Road is mixed and that zoning along the busy road will be an issue in the map process of 1992.

Testifying to the merit of the documented plan and the B.L. some was Mr. George Gavrelis, former Director of Planning for Baltimore County and expert in land planning. Mr. Gavrelis traced the recent history of Belair Road and residential properties that have had to absorb the impact of traffic as Perry Hall has grown. He asserted that existing vacant lots on Belair Road are unsuitable

The personal desires of the Petitioner are understandable, but in the fact of evidence and testimony, the Board cannot find error on the part of the County Council. The residential appearance and characteristics of Soth Avenue and Beleir Road do not warrant the potentialities of a B.L. zone under present circumstances. For these reasons the Board finds that the reclassification should be denied and will so order.

Mr. Gavrelis further testified that the proposed structure is compatible with houses in the neighborhood and has rational use in a community that calls for services. He stated that the proposed structure would have no impact on public utilities and was in accord with recommendations of the Planning Board in providing access from Soth Avenue.

In response to People's Counsel, Mr. Gavrelis concurred that the property was an issue in 1988 as well as other properties in the 9100 block, and all remained residential.

Mr. C. Richard Moore, chief of traffic engineering for the Baltimore County Department of Public Works, testified that the total trips generated at the site would be 105 trips a day and that the impact at Belair Road and Soth Avenue would be very small. He acknowledged that any increased traffic from Belair Road onto Soth Avenue under present conditions would be undesirable

Mr. Jeffrey Long of the Beltimore County Office of Planning Zoning responded to questioning by the People's Counsel, testifying in meneral that the proposed office building is inconsistent with the Master Plan for the vicinity that specified no further commercial zoning on Belair Road until further study. Mr. Long stated that there are many requests for commercial zoning along Belair Road. residential lot. Mr. Long felt that the matter would be appropriate in the Comprehensive Zoning Process, and that there was so error in the 1988 woning issues of the site as it could be developed for residential purposes

Various residents of the neighborhood testified to their opposition to the commercial use of the subject property. Their protests centered primarily on the existing and increasing traffic and parking difficulties along Soth Avenue, which is a gateway road to their community. The commercial activity oriented to Soth avenue was viewed as a negative intrusion. A domino effect could result as the spot commercial zoning could move along Belsir Road.

In response to Counsel for the Petitioner, it was acknowledged by a protestant that the Perry Hall Community Association has not taken a stance on the Documented Site 71sn.

OPINION

Section 2-58.1(1)(2) of the Baltimore County Code mandates that, before any property is reclassified pursuant to this section, the Board of Appeals must find that "there has occurred a substantial change in the character of the neighborhood in which the property is located since the property was last classified, or that the last classification was in error " Testimony in this case has centered on the appropriateness of a small residential parcel situated on a heavily-travelled highway as it passes through a predominantly residential community.
