FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owner, Jean Romadka, by and through her attorney, Robert J. Romadka, Esquire. The Petitioner requests a variance from Section 1802.3.C.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a side yard setback of 2 feet in lieu of the minimum required 10 feet, for proposed additions to an existing dwelling, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted and there being no requests for public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits as required by Section 26-127 (b)(1) of the Baltimore County Code. Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variances would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, the information, pictures, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship

upon the Petitioners.

This property is located within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas on Middle River and as such, is subject to any recommendations made by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) as to Critical Areas requirements. The granting of the relief requested in this matter is conditioned upon compliance with any comments submitted by DEPRM upon completion of their review.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the B.C.Z.R. having been met, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this 8^{-1} day of December, 1992 that the Petition for Administrative Variance requesting relief from Section 1B02.3.C.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a side yard setback of 2 feet in lieu of the minimum required 10 feet, for proposed additions to an existing dwelling, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions:

> 1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

2) Compliance with any recommendations made by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) upon completion of their review.

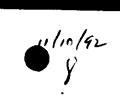
