FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Exception for the property located at 8869 Citation Road in Essex. The Petition was filed by Gordon M. Roberts, Jr., and Mary A. Roberts, his wife, property owners, and Dirt First, Inc., by Andris Lagzdins, President, Lessee. The Petition for Special Exception requests approval for use of the subject site as a service garage and repair shop for motorcycles. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly shown on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1, the plat to accompany the Petition for Special Exception.

Appearing at the public hearing held for this case were Gordon M. Roberts, Jr., property owner, and Andris Lagzdins, Lessee. The Petitioners were represented by Philip J. Kotchenreuther, Esquire. Also present were Joseph W. McGraw, Jr., the surveyor who prepared the site plan, and Henry Cornblatt, a commercial real estate agent, who represented Mr. Lagzdins in connection with the proposed lease. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence presented was that the subject property is approximately 1.1532 acres in area, zoned M.L.-I.M. The site is an irregularly shaped lot located adjacent to Citation Road in the Pulaski Industrial Park in eastern Baltimore County. The property is improved with an existing building, which is approximately 11,100 sq. ft. in area. The

building is owned by Mr. and Mrs. Roberts and is occupied by his company, Eagle Engineering. Mr. Roberts indicated that his company is in the business of the distribution of power transmission products and has been operating from this site for approximately 10 years.

Mr. Roberts and his wife have entered into a lease with Mr. Lagzdins for the rental of a portion of the building for his business known as Dirt First, Inc. Slightly less than 50% of the building (approx. 5300 sq. ft.) will be leased. Certain internal and external modifications to the building and property will be made to accommodate the tenant and new use.

Mr. Lagzdins testified that he owns and operates the business known as Dirt First, Inc. This is a family business which was originally started in his home and has expanded. Presently, the business operates from a location in Baltimore City, however, additional space is needed. The business employs three persons, including Mr. Lagzdins, and specializes in the repair of motorcycles and motorcycle parts as well as the warehousing, distribution and sales of these vehicles and parts. Mr. Lagzdins described the operation of the business in some detail, including the procedures which were in place to dispose of petroleum products and other environmentally damaging materials. He indicated that the business primarily performs mechanical repairs of inoperable motorcycles and also stores and sells parts, primarily on a retail basis.

Additional testimony offered was that there are similar businesses in the area. In addition to Mr. Roberts power transmission products business in the building, an Alban Tractor business is located across the street as well as a Marex Fuel Oil Distribution Center nearby. Both of these relate to the sale, service, or repair of engines and/or motor vehicles. In fact, the Office of Planning within its Zoning Plans Advisory Committee comment

noted its support for the proposed special exception in that the site is located within an industrial park and is compatible with surrounding uses.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, all of which was uncontradicted, I am persuaded to grant the Petition for Special Exception. I agree with the Office of Planning's assessment that the proposed use is appropriate for this site. Clearly, the proposed use will not cause any detrimental impact to the health safety or general welfare of the locale. I find that the Petitioners have satisfied the criteria set forth in Section 502.1 of the BCZR. Thus, the Petition for Special Exception shall be granted.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons given above, the relief requested should be granted.

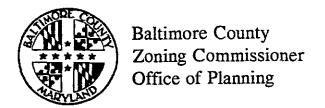

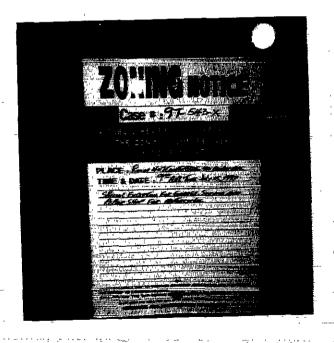

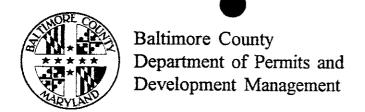

I advised the engineer to resubmit property descriptions that describe the tenant space for the proposed special exception use. I will also advise him to present a plan to that extent.
