#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner on a Petition for a Zoning Variance for the property located at 9315 Pulaski Highway in eastern Baltimore County. The Petition was filed by Eric G. Kron and Eric B. Bowen, property owners. Variance relief is requested from Section 255.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR) to allow a side yard setback of 15 ft. in lieu of the required 30 ft. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly shown on the plat to accompany the Petition for Variance, marked as Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1.

Appearing at the public hearing held for this case was Eric G. Kron, property owner/Petitioner. Also present was James E. Matis, the engineer who prepared the site plan. The Petitioners were represented by H. Barnes Mowell, Esquire. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence presented was that the subject property is roughly rectangular in shape, approximately .70 acres in area, split zoned M.L.-A.S. and M.L.-I.M. The property is located immediately adjacent to Pulaski Highway (U.S.Route 40 East), not far from Middle River Road in eastern Baltimore County. The property is owned by Mr. Kron and Mr. Bowen who are also the owners of an excavation business. Presently, they store equipment on the site for use in connection with their business. In addition to a parking area for storage, the property is also presently

improved with an existing one story concrete building.

Testimony and evidence offered is that the Petitioners intend on razing the existing building and will construct a new building in its place. The new building will contain 1,008 sq. ft. of office space and 3264 sq. ft. of warehouse space, plus an additional 1400 sq. ft. for storage on a mezzanine level. The proposed building will be located on the west side of the property, approximately 15 ft. from the side property line. It was indicated at the hearing that the building's location was chosen to accommodate the existing access/egress points and parking lot. That is, if the building was placed in the middle of the site so as to strictly comply with all setback requirements, the traffic flow on and off site would be disrupted and the area for parking and outdoor storage would be inappropriately limited. Thus, the proposed building is to be located closer to the side property line, in order to preserve these features.

Copies of several letters obtained by the Petitioners in support of the Petition were submitted. These letters were signed by neighboring property owners or users and indicate no objection to the proposed variance. Moreover, there were no adverse Zoning Plans Advisory Committee comments.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, all of which was uncontradicted, I am persuaded to grant the Petition for Variance. In my judgment, the Petitioners have satisfied the requirements set forth in Section 307 of the BCZR, as construed by the case law. The proposed location of the new building appears appropriate and variance relief should be granted. In this regard, it should be noted that the adjoining business which shares the common property line most affected is owned by a container storage operation. The proposed use will clearly not have any detrimental impact on that business or land use.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons given above, the relief requested should be granted.

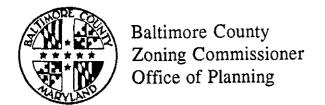
THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this Ag day of August 1997 that a variance from Section 255.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR) to allow a side yard setback of 15 ft., in lieu of the required 30 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions:

- 1. The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. The Petitioners shall comply with all requirements of the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) as set forth in their comments dated July 31, 1997.

3. When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.
