FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as Petitions for Special Hearing and Variances for that property known as 8801, 8803, 8807, 8809, 8813 & 8815 Stoneridge Circle, and 8901, 8903, 8905 & 8907 Stonecreek Place located off McDonough Road in the vicinity of Owings Mills. were filed by the owners of the property, Stoneridge Associates, LLC and Stoneridge Condominium, Inc. by Michael J. Reiser, Member and Vice President, respectively, and Domain Builders, Petitioner, through their attorney, G. Scott Barhight, Esquire. The Petitioners request a Special Hearing to approve an amendment to the previously approved Final Development Plan for Stoneridge, and variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR) (1989), Section 1B.01.2.C.2.b and CMDP (1989), Section V.B.6.c to permit 10 feet between opposing windows in lieu of the required 40 feet. The subject property and relief sought are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted and marked into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the Petitioners was Mark Stemen and Chip Merlin, of Domain Builders. Also appearing were Ed Haile, a professional

civil engineer, and Melanie Moser, an expert in Planning & Zoning, on behalf of Daft-McCune-Walker, who prepared the site plan for this project. There were no protestants present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property consists of 8.409 acres, more or less, zoned D.R. 3.5. The property was the subject of a previous CRG approval known as Foxridge, Section 1, Parcel C-2 (formerly the Chase at Foxridge). The Petitioners have obtained all necessary approvals and permits to develop and begin construction of the project in accordance with Petitioners' Exhibit 1. The project consists of 12 multifamily buildings for sale as condominiums as an affordable housing project. Approximately half of the units have been constructed at this point in time. Two of the buildings are currently under construction.

Apparently, notwithstanding the previous approvals of all County agencies, the Zoning Office has recently determined that the buildings with opposing windows 10 feet apart are in need of zoning variances and that the connection between these buildings to meet the height to height/distance requirements of the BCZR needs to be modified as shown on the previously approved Final Development Plan. Mr. Stemen testified that the Petitioner believed that all of the requirements of Baltimore County were previously met, but that based upon the request of the Zoning Office, he was willing to file the variances and special hearing requested by the Zoning Office in order to obtain the release of future building permits. Mr. Stemen further testified that the existing residents enjoy the windows and have never complained about the distances between the opposing windows. Mr. Stemen also testified that

prospective homeowners see the windows as a positive feature and prefer them to blank walls which would not permit the flow of light and air.

Ms. Moser testified with regard to the unique characteristics of the subject site. Almost half of the site has been rendered unbuildable by environmental requirements, including a stream valley park which was dedicated to Baltimore County at no cost. The balance of the site also contains significant slopes which the Petitioner has attempted to ameliorate by removing approximately 70,000 cubic yards of dirt from the site. All of these unique site characteristics have created a situation where the buildings need to be clustered closer together to be able to fit on the site. Ms. Moser also submitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 2, a drawing showing the connection between buildings to meet functional and aesthetics requirements of the BCZR to comply with the height to height/distance between buildings set-back requirements. Ms. Moser also described the practical difficulty arising out of these unique features and testified that the opposing windows were actually a benefit to the homeowners and consistent with the spirit and intent of the BCZR to provide affordable, livable residences that have adequate light and air. also testified that under the current BCZR that the proposed distance between opposing windows would be permitted as a matter of right.

An area variance may be granted where strict application of the Zoning Regulations would cause practical difficulty to the Petitioner and his property. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioner must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with the requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

It is clear from the testimony that if the variance is granted, such use, as proposed, will not be contrary to the spirit of the BCZR and will not result in any injury to the public good. If fact, since the Petitioner proceeded in good faith to construct several of the proposed buildings, the evidence clearly shows that the actual use with the opposing windows as constructed is a benefit to the citizens who reside therein.

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the special hearing relief and variances are not granted. It has been established that the proposed amendments to the previously approved Final Development Plan are necessary in order to proceed with the proposed improvements in a manner consistent with the BCZR. Furthermore, special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land and structures which are the subject of the variance request and the requirements from which the Petitioner seeks relief will unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unique to this particular parcel. In the opinion of this Deputy Zoning Commissioner,

the relief requested will not cause any injury to the public health, safety or general welfare and meets the spirit and intent of the BCZR.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons given above, the relief requested should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this Aday of September, 1997, that the Petition for Special Hearing to amend the Final Development Plan for Stoneridge in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibits 1 and 2, be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (1989), Section 1B.01.2.C.2.b and CMDP (1989), Section V.B.6.c to permit 10 feet between opposing windows in lieu of the required 40 feet, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restriction:

1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.
