FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Hearing for the property located at 1307 Sulphur Spring Road in Arbutus. The Petition was filed by Mark G. Bastille and Bettina Bastille, property owners. Relief is requested to confirm a nonconforming use for a three family (apartment) dwelling and to confirm the nonconforming status, pursuant to Section 402.2, as to: (1) A width at the front building line of 50 ft., in lieu of the required 105 ft; (2) a lot area of 6922 sq. ft., in lieu of the required 13,000 sq. ft.; and (3) side yard setbacks of 10 ft. each, in lieu of the required 20 ft. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly shown on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1, the plat to accompany the Petition for Special Hearing.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing held for this case was Mark G. Bastille, property owner/co-Petitioner. The Petitioners were represented by Stephen J. Nolan, Esquire. Also appearing and testifying on behalf of the Petitioners was Janet Cearfoss, former owner of the property. A number of individuals appeared in opposition to the request. Serving as spokespersons for these individuals was Keith Hartig, Kathy Hartig and Sheri Stocksdale. The full list of Protestants who appeared is contained on the Protestants Sign-in Sheet which has been incorporated into the record of this case.

An examination of the site plan shows that the subject property is approximately .158 acres in area, zoned D.R.5.5. The lot is a corner property, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Sulphur Spring Road and Willys Avenue in Arbutus. The lot is approximately 50 ft. wide at its frontage on Sulphur Spring Road and tapers slightly to a width of 54.17 ft. at the rear property line. The depth of the property ranges from 131.15 ft. to 133.25 ft. The property is improved with a 2-1/2 story frame dwelling. The dwelling fronts Sulphur Spring Road, however, there are several entrances from different sides of the house. The property also contains 12-1/2 ft. by 18 ft. detached garage in the rear yard, which is served by a small macadam drive.

Mr. Bastille, and his wife, purchased the property in March of 1996. Presently, Mr. Bastille testified that three apartment units are maintained in the building. A floor plan showing each of the apartment units is contained on the site plan. The floor plan drawings show a basement apartment which contains one bedroom, kitchen, bathroom and other living area; a one bedroom, kitchen, bathroom and open living room area on the first floor; and, a two bedroom (including an attic), kitchen, bathroom and living room area in the upstairs apartment. Mr. Bastille testified extensively about the layout of these units and about the use of these three apartments since the time of his purchase of the property. He also described in some detail the renovations he had undertaken to improve the property and discussed numerous tenants who have rented from him since the date of his purchase of the site.

The Petitioner seeks a designation of the property as a nonconforming use, as that term is defined in Section 101 of the BCZR and regulated by Section 104. A nonconforming use is defined in Section 101 as "A legal use that does not conform to a use regulation for the zone in which it is located or to a special regulation applicable to such a use." In essence,

the nonconforming use designation is utilized to grandfather an otherwise illegal use. That is, if a Petitioner can establish that a particular use existed prior to the date of the zoning regulation which prohibits that use, the use may remain as nonconforming. As noted above, nonconforming uses are regulated in Section 104 of the BCZR. It is of particular note that this section requires that a nonconforming use cannot be discontinued or abandoned for a period of one year or more. In such an event, the right to continue or resume the nonconforming use will terminate.

In an effort to establish his nonconforming use, Mr. Bastille presented the testimony of Janet Cearfoss, the prior owner of the property. Ms. Cearfoss is elderly (80 years old) and sold the property to Mr. Bastille She testified extensively about her former occupancy of the in 1996. property and her family's long ownership of the site. Apparently, the property has been in her family for many years and the house was originally built by her parents in 1924. She testified somewhat inconsistently about the occupancy of the site since then. Essentially, she concluded that the property had always been used as a three apartment building since the years during World War II. However, when questioned specifically, she was unable to recall specific tenants and her testimony was not persuasive in supporting the Petitioner's claim that the three apartment use had continued uninterruptedly over the years.

In opposition to the request, testimony was received from a number of the neighbors. Among those who testified were Richard Kidd, Kathy Hartig, Sheri Stocksdale, Janice A. Little and Keith Hartig. It is of particular note that many of the Protestants have lived in the area for many years. Many of the witnesses testified that they had resided in the area as children, moved away briefly during early adulthood, and then purchased houses in the neighborhood and returned to raise their families in this

community. Clearly, this is a well established community with strong residential roots.

The cumulative testimony of the Protestants was dispositive to the conclusion that the building has been used as a two apartment complex since prior to 1945 and has continued uninterruptedly since that time. Mrs. Stocksdale, in particular, testified that she remembered playing in the house as a child with the children of the tenants who lived in the upstairs unit at that time. Documentary evidence offered by Mrs. Hartig also showed that the property was registered with the State of Maryland for the purpose of property tax assessment as a two apartment unit during the 1950s.

As noted during the hearing, the first substantive set of zoning regulations were adopted in Baltimore County in 1945. The property is presently zoned D.R.5.5; therefore, in order for the nonconforming status to be conferred, the Petitioner must show that the three apartment use existed prior to the effective date of those regulations. Moreover, it must be shown that the use has been uninterrupted since 1945.

As I stated at the conclusion of the hearing, I am indeed persuaded that the use is nonconforming so as to allow two apartment units. The testimony from Ms. Cearfoss was helpful in reaching this conclusion. She did unequivocally state that there were at least two apartment units for many years which were occupied by various members of her extended family. The fact that these tenants were family members does not, in my judgment, alter the two apartment character of the building. Moreover, as noted above, the documentary evidence and all testimony by the Protestants supported this conclusion.

However, the overwhelming weight of the testimony was also that the building has not been continuously and uninterruptedly used as a three apartment structure. Although there is a basement unit at the present

time, it appears that the basement was uninhabitable for many years and not occupied. Additionally, during other periods that the premises were livable, the basement area was used in conjunction with the first floor unit.

Based upon the cumulative testimony and evidence offered, therefore, I am persuaded to grant the Petition for Special Hearing, in part, and deny same, in part. Nonconforming use status will be conferred on the subject property to continue the use of the premises as a two apartment However, the Petitioner shall not be allowed to maintain three apartments and the basement apartment unit must be vacated as a separate unit within 60 days from the date of this Order. Additionally, it is clear that the footprint of the building and exterior of the structure has not been materially altered over the years. There have been some changes as to the entrances to the premises, however, the building's footprint has remained unchanged. Thus, nonconforming status will be granted as to the width of the building at the front property line, the lot area and the side yard setbacks. It is clear that these conditions have existed since the building was constructed in the 1920s.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons given above, the relief requested should be granted, in part, and denied, in part.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County this day of July 1998 that, pursuant to the Petition for Special Hearing, approval to continue the use of the premises as a two apartment building, be and is hereby GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a nonconforming use status as to Section 402.2 of the BCZR, to allow a width at the front building line of 50 ft., in lieu of the required 105 ft; a lot area of 6922 sq. ft., in lieu of the required 13,000 sq. ft.; and side yard setbacks of 10 ft. each, in lieu of

the required 20 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions:

- 1. The Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired.
- 2. The structure can be used only for two apartments, and the third apartment located in the basement must be removed as a separate unit within 60 days from the date of this Order.

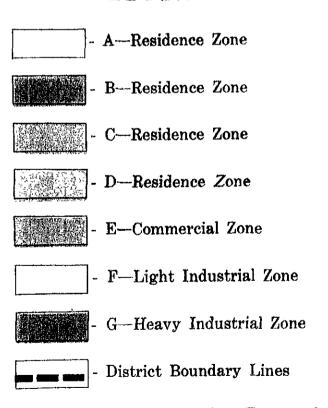
ZONING MAP OF BALTIMORE COUNTY MARYLAND

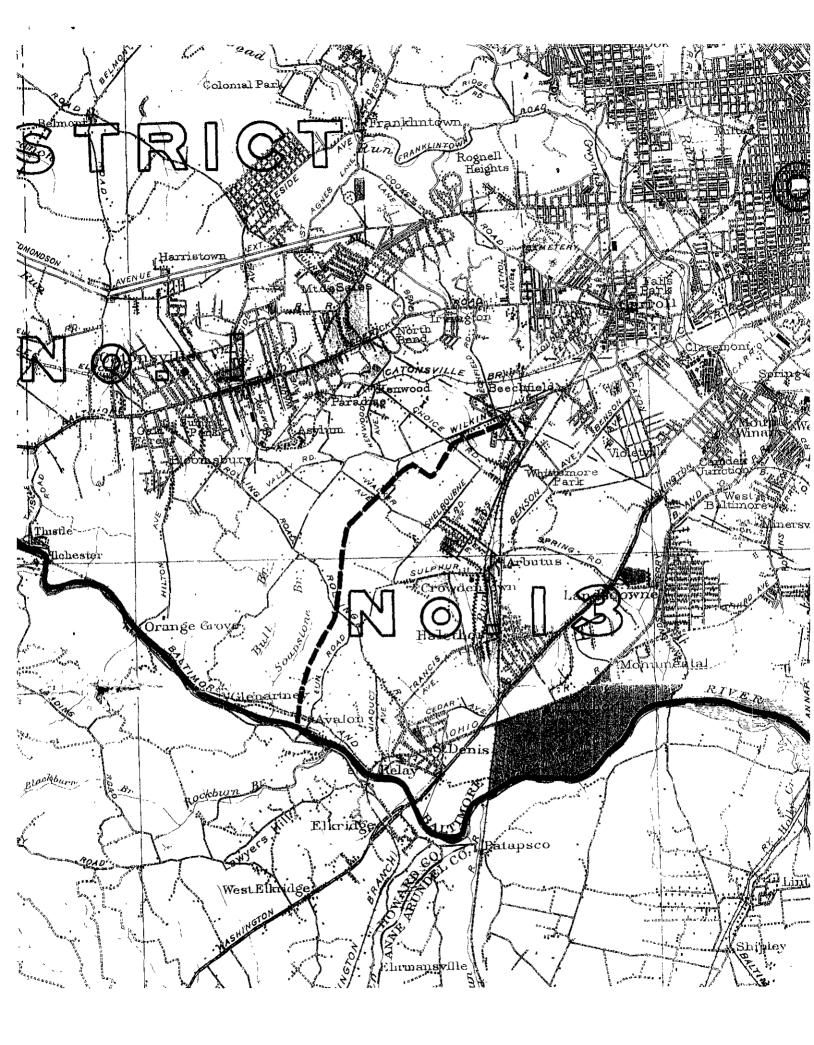
