FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owner of the subject property, Edward W. Backhaus, and the Contract Purchaser, Ferlin Ray Baisden. The Petitioners seek relief from Sections 1A04.3.B.3 and 304 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a front setback of 38 feet, 6 inches in lieu of the required 75 feet from the street centerline, and side setbacks of 10 feet and 14 feet in lieu of the required 50 feet each, and to approve the subject property as an undersized lot, pursuant to Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R., and any other variances as deemed necessary by the Zoning Commissioner. The subject property and relief sought are more particularly described on the site plan submitted, which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the Petition were Ferlin Ray Baisden, Contract Purchaser, and John Fisher, Contractor. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is a rectangular shaped, waterfront lot, located on the south side of Bay Drive, with frontage on the Chesapeake Bay in Bowleys Quarters. The property consists of a gross area of .26 acres (9,365 sq.ft.), more or less, zoned R.C.5, and is currently improved with a block dwelling and two sheds. As noted above, Mr. Baisden is under contract to purchase the property from Mr. Backhaus. He proposes to raze the existing dwelling and construct a new dwelling in its place, utilizing the foundation of the existing dwelling. The new dwelling will be 26 feet wide by 52 feet in depth, and will be one story in height. The new construction will overhang the existing foundation and be both deeper and wider than the existing

dwelling. Mr. Baisden testified that the existing structure is uninhabitable; however, the foundation is sound and can support the new building. Additionally, the Petitioner proposes to utilize the existing foundation so that the living quarters of the new building will be elevated and meet minimum floodplain requirements.

Based upon the testimony and evidence offered, I am persuaded to grant the Petition for Variance. The uniqueness of this property is found in its unusual configuration. Clearly, the property cannot meet the R.C.5 zoning regulations in view of its narrow width and small size. Moreover, I am persuaded that the razing of the existing structure and the replacement of same with a new dwelling will actually enhance the neighborhood and will not cause any detrimental impact to surrounding properties. For these reasons, I am persuaded to grant the Petition for Variance. However, in granting same, I will impose certain conditions and limitations.

Specifically, the Office of Planning submitted Zoning Plans Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments in which they suggested that an existing chain link fence be replaced with an attractive enclosure, such as a picket fence. Additionally, that Office believes that the two masonry sheds should be removed, due to their dilapidated condition and incompatibility with the proposed improvements. I am inclined to adopt both of these proposals. The upgrade of this property by razing the existing dwelling and constructing a new house warrants a further upgrade of the property by removal of the chain link fence and the replacement of same with a picket fence or more appropriate barrier. Additionally, in that the new house will be larger than the existing dwelling, it is assumed that additional storage space will be provided therein and thus the need for the sheds is questionable. In the event the Petitioner wishes to replace the sheds with a new structure, same could be considered. Also, I will adopt the requirements set forth in the ZAC comments submitted by the Bureau of Development Plans Review Division of the Department of Permits and Development Management (DPDM), relative to Federal Flood Insurance requirements. As noted above, the Petitioner intends on utilizing the existing foundation and elevating the living quarters of the new building to meet these flood regulations. Thus, as a condition precedent to the issuance of a building permit, I will require that the Petitioner meet those standards. Lastly, the property is located within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas. As such, the Petitioner shall comply with any recommendations made by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) to mitigate any impact the proposed development may have on the Bay.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth herein, the relief requested shall be granted.

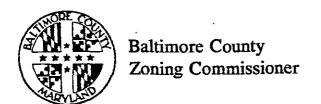
THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of August, 1999 that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Sections 1A04.3.B.3 and 304 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a front setback of 38 feet, 6 inches in lieu of the required 75 feet from the street centerline, and side setbacks of 10 feet and 14 feet in lieu of the required 50 feet each, for a proposed dwelling, and to approve the subject property as an undersized lot, pursuant to Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R., in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restrictions:

- 1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.
- 2) Compliance with the Zoning Plans Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments submitted by the Office of Planning, dated June 11, 1999, and the Bureau of Development Plans Review, dated June 16, 1999, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3) Compliance with any recommendations made by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM).
- 4) When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

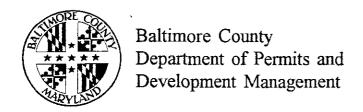

The Bureau of Development Plans Review has reviewed the subject zoning item. The property to be developed is located adjacent to tidewater. The Developer is advised that the proper sections of the Baltimore County Building Code must be followed whereby elevation limitations are placed on the lowest floor (including basements) of residential (commercial) development.

In conformance with Federal Flood Insurance requirements, the first floor or basement floor must be at least 1 foot over the flood plain elevation in all construction.

The minimum flood protection elevation is 11 feet for this site using Baltimore County Datum.

Basements are not permitted in the flood plain area.

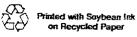

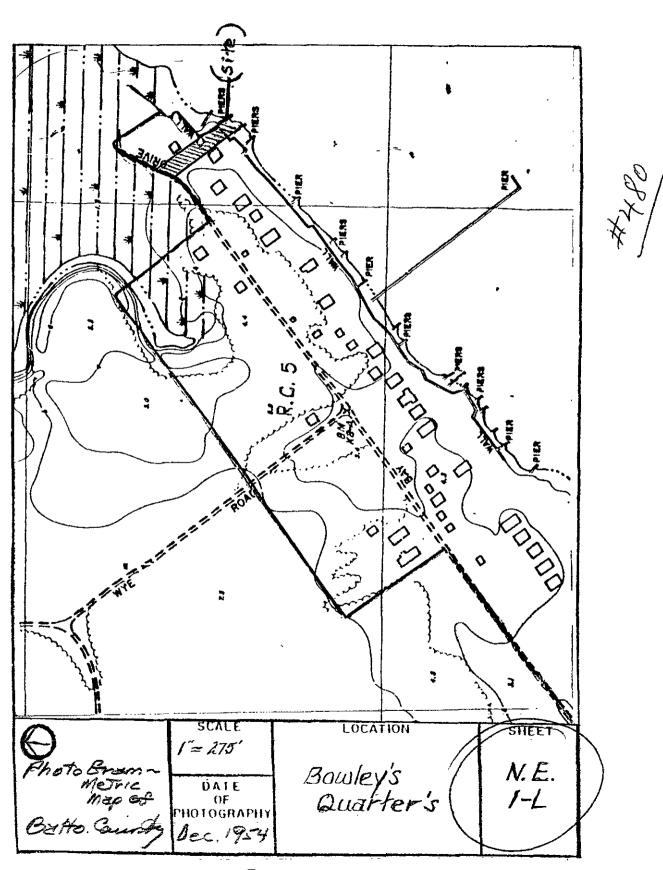
