#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Woodrow W. Johnson. The variance request is for property located at 17441 Troyer Road in the Monkton area of Baltimore County. The Petitioner herein seeks a variance from Sections 400.1 (101 definitions) and 400.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to allow an accessory structure (detached garage) to be larger than the dwelling and with a height of 35 ft. (lowest grade to peak) in lieu of the required smaller than the dwelling and 15 ft. respectively. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1, the plat to accompany the Petition for Administrative Variance.

The Petitioner having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioner has filed the supporting affidavits as required by Section 26-127 (b)(1) of the Baltimore County Code. Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the

requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioner.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

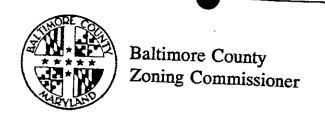
THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this Aday of June, 2000, that a variance from Sections 400.1 (101 definitions) and 400.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to allow an accessory structure (detached garage) to be larger than the dwelling and with a height of 35 ft. (lowest grade to peak) in lieu of the required smaller than the dwelling and 15 ft. respectively, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions which are conditions precedent to the relief granted herein:

- 1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2) The Petitioners or subsequent owners shall not allow or cause the garage to be converted to a second dwelling unit and/or apartment. The structure shall contain no living or sleeping quarters, and no kitchen or bathroom facilities. In addition, the accessory structure should not be used for commercial purposes.
- 3) Landscaping should be provided along the southern side of the proposed structure. A landscaping plan should be submitted to the Office of Planning for review and approval prior to the issuance of any building permit.
- 4) When applying for a building permit, the site plan/landscaping plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.
