FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Hearing, Special Exception and Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Armando Cignarelli, on behalf of 2401 York Road, LLC. The Petitioners are requesting a Special Exception to allow a Class B office building in a R.O. zone. In addition, a special hearing is requested to amend the previously approved special exception in Case No. 98-146-SPHX. Finally, the following variances are requested:

- 1. A variance from Section 204.4.C.3 to allow a front yard setback of 22 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 25 ft.;
- 2. A variance from Section 204.4.C.4 to allow a side yard setback to an adjacent residential street of 5 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 20 ft.;

- 3. A variance from Section 204.4.4.C.5 to allow a rear yard setback to 12 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 30 ft.;
- 4. A variance from Section 204.4.C.6 to allow an amenity open space of 0% of the interior of the parking lot in lieu of the minimum required 7%;
- 5. A variance from Section 204.4.C.9.c.(1) to allow a 12 ft. wide landscape buffer (rear) adjacent to a residentially used and zoned property in lieu of the minimum required 20 ft., and a 5 ft. wide landscape buffer adjacent to a residential street in lieu of the minimum required 20 ft.; and
- 6. A variance from Section 204.4.C.9.c.(2) to allow a 2 ft. wide landscape buffer to a non-residentially zoned property (adjacent to the north) in lieu of the minimum required 10 ft., and a 0 ft. wide landscape buffer to a non-residentially zoned property (#2401 York Road) in lieu of the minimum required 10 ft.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the requests were Armando Cignarelli, Joe Maranto and Thomas Faust, on behalf of 2401 York Road, LLC, and Geoffrey Schultz from McKee & Associates, Inc., the engineering firm who prepared the site plan of the property. The Petitioners were represented by John Gontrum, attorney at law.

Appearing in opposition to the Petitioners' request were many residents of the surrounding community, all of whom signed in on the Protestants' Sign-In Sheet.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this request, is a rectangularly shaped parcel of property located on the northeast corner of the intersection of York Road and E. Main Boulevard in the Timonium area of Baltimore County. The subject property is approximately 64 ft. x 169 ft. in size. It is split-zoned RO/DR 3.5. The subject property is currently improved with an existing one-story office building wherein the Petitioner, Armando Cignarelli, maintains his office. The purpose of this request is to allow the Petitioner to construct an additional one-story office building consisting of 1,200 sq. ft. on the rear of the property as shown on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1, the site plan submitted. The property already has sufficient parking to meet the needs of not only the existing office building, but also the one

proposed to the rear of the site. Therefore, the only construction proposed at this time is a 1,200 sq. ft., one-story office building which is intended to be occupied by the Petitioner. In order to proceed with the construction of this one-story office building, the special exception, special hearing and variance requests are necessary.

It should be noted that the Petitioner was given approval to construct a second story onto the existing office building which currently fronts on York Road. That approval was granted in Case No. 98-146-SPHX. In that case, the Petitioner was granted approval to add an additional 2,000 sq. ft. of office space by way of a second story addition on the existing building. However, the Petitioner's plans have changed and he is now desirous of constructing a smaller one-story building on the rear of the property which would result in 2 one-story buildings on the property as opposed to a two-story building on the front of the site. Mr. Cignarelli believed that constructing two separate buildings would provide for a better design of the site. Mr. Cignarelli indicated that he would construct the second story addition consisting of 2,000 sq. ft. in the event his alternative proposal is denied herein.

Appearing in staunch opposition to the construction of a second office building on the property were several residents of the surrounding neighborhood. All of the residents testified that they are opposed to the construction of this second office building and would prefer to see the second story constructed on the existing building. They appreciate the open space that currently exists to the rear of this site and would like to see that area of the property remain undisturbed. This neighborhood already suffers from commercial encroachment by virtue of the 2 three-story office buildings that currently exist on either side of this property. Therefore, they ask that the Petitioners' request be denied and that he build the second story addition according to his previous approvals.

After considering the testimony and evidence offered at the hearing, I find that the Petitioners' request should be denied. While I agree with Mr. Cignarelli that the construction of a smaller one-story building may be a better design of the property, it is requested more as a preference than necessity. The Petitioner already has approval to construct an additional 2,000 sq. ft. of office space on the property. Therefore, there is no necessity presented in this case to justify the second building being constructed to the rear of the property, even though it is proposed to be constructed with a lesser amount of square footage. The Petitioner can simply proceed with the construction of the second story addition and thereby meet his needs for additional office space. Accordingly, the Petitions for Special Exception, Special Hearing and Variance shall be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 21 day of August, 2000, by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the Petitioner's Request for Special Exception, to allow a Class B office building in a R.O. zone, be and is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner's Request for Special Hearing, to amend the previously approved special exception in Case No. 98-146-SPHX, be and is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner's Request for Variances: 1) from Section 204.4.C.3 to allow a front yard setback of 22 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 25 ft.; 2) from Section 204.4.C.4 to allow a side yard setback to an adjacent residential street of 5 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 20 ft.; 3) from Section 204.4.C.5 to allow a rear yard setback to 12 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 30 ft.; 4) from Section 204.4.C.6 to allow an amenity open space of 0% of the interior of the parking lot in lieu of the minimum required 7%; 5) from Section 204.4.C.9.c.(1) to allow a 12 ft. wide landscape buffer (rear) adjacent to a residentially used and zoned property in lieu of the minimum required 20 ft., and a 5 ft. wide landscape buffer adjacent

to a residential street in lieu of the minimum required 20 ft.; and 6) from Section 204.4.C.9.c.(2) to allow a 2 ft. wide landscape buffer to a non-residentially zoned property (adjacent to the north) in lieu of the minimum required 10 ft., and a 0 ft. wide landscape buffer to a non-residentially zoned property (#2401 York Road) in lieu of the minimum required 10 ft., be and they are hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

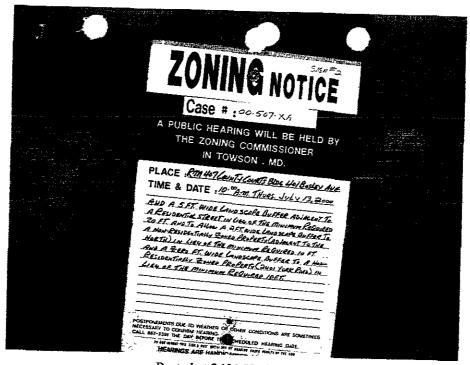

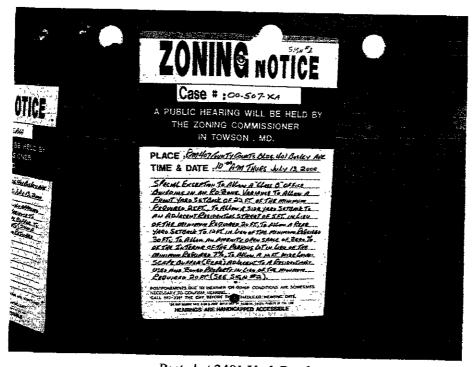

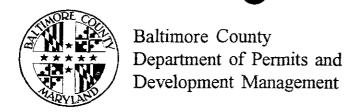

The number of setback variances and waivers of the landscape buffer requirements necessitated by the proposed development indicate that the site is not adequate for additional development of this scale. Additionally, the fact that the proposed office structure extends into the residentially zoned community does not comply with the intent of the RO zoning classification which provides for the conversion of residential structures to office use, and/or the construction of Class B office buildings where adequate buffers exist. It is the determination of this office that the site is currently developed to it's capacity, and that any further development could jeopardize the adequacy of traffic circulation, parking, and sufficient buffers, ultimately affecting the stability of the adjacent residential community.

The Bureau of Development Plans Review has reviewed the subject zoning item. Main Boulevard is an existing road which shall ultimately be improved as a 30-foot street cross section on a 50-foot right-of-way.

The developer's responsibilities along the existing road frontage of the subdivision shall be as follows:

- The submission of detailed construction drawings to extend a minimum distance of 200 feet beyond the limits of the subdivision or as may be required to establish line and grade.
- ❖ The submission of full cross-sections is deemed necessary for design and/or construction purposes. The sections are to be taken at 25-foot intervals and are to be shown on standard cross-section paper at 1"=5' horizontal to 1"=5' vertical scale.
- The preparation of the right-of-way plat for, and the dedication of any widening and slope easements at no cost to the county.
- The preparation of the right-of-way plats for any offsite road right-of-way required to make the necessary improvements.
- The grading of the widening and the existing road to the established grade. Where adjacent properties are adversely affected by the improvements, the developer shall be financially responsible for the necessary repairs to these properties.
- The relocation of any utilities or poles as required by the road improvements.
- The construction of combination curb and gutter in its ultimate location and a maximum of 28.5 feet of paving adjacent thereto along the frontage of the property. The paving thickness shall conform with Baltimore County standards.

The entrance locations are subject to approval by the Bureau.

Entrances shall be a minimum of 24 feet and a maximum of 35 feet wide, shall have 10-foot minimum radii curb returns, shall be located a minimum of 15 feet from any property line, and shall be constructed in accordance with Baltimore County standards as the developer's total responsibility.

Sidewalks are required on both sides of the streets within this subdivision and/or along the frontage of all existing streets including state roads. The walks shall be 5 feet wide and shall be installed to conform with Baltimore County standards.
