FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Vernell G. Marvel and the contract purchaser, Joseph F. France. The variance request is for property located at 3017 Ohio Avenue, located in the Baltimore Highlands area of Baltimore County. The variance request is from Sections 1B02.3.C.1 and 304 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to permit a dwelling on a lot with a width of 50 ft. in lieu of the required 55 ft.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the variance request were Thomas Diggs and Gilbert France. Mr. Joseph France, the contract purchaser was unable to attend the hearing. There were no protestants or other persons in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this variance request, consists of 0.143 acres, more or less, zoned DR 5.5. The subject property is unimproved at this time. It is part and parcel of an overall tract of property owned by the Petitioner, Vernell Marvel. The subject case is a companion case to Case Nos. 01-222-A, 01-225-A and 01-226-A. This request involves Lots 64 and 65. The Petitioner proposes to construct a dwelling as shown on the site plan submitted. The dwelling is proposed to be 20 ft. wide and 40 ft. long. It has side yard setbacks of 15 ft. on either side. The site plan submitted into evidence at the hearing shows

hearing shows the design and layout of the house to be built on the property. It should be noted that the house situated to the east of the proposed dwelling has a 0 ft. side yard setback. There is apparently a house on Lots 62 and 63, which is the lot immediately to the west of the proposed house. However, the Petitioner has failed to show on the site plan the location of that house. I have no idea of knowing whether the house on the west side of the proposed lot is 0 ft. from the property line or 10 ft. from the property line.

It should also be noted that the Office of Planning has taken a strong position in opposition to the Petitioners' request. The Planning Office recommends denial on the variance request and has disapproved the undersized lot submittal. After considering the testimony and evidence offered at the hearing, I find that the variance request to allow a dwelling to be constructed on Lots 64 and 65 should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this ______ day of February, 2001, by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the Petitioners' request for variance from Sections 1B02.3.C.1 and 304 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to permit a dwelling on a lot with a width of 50 ft. in lieu of the required 55 ft., be and is hereby DENIED.

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

It appears that the property owners, William and Vernell Marvel, own Lots 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69 and 70 in the subdivision of Baltimore Highlands. The Office of Planning has recently reviewed undersized lot requests for the properties located at 3017, 3021, and 3023 Ohio Avenue. In addition, the office also reviewed a variance for the property located at 3019 Ohio Ave. The assemblage of small lots—in single ownership—to create building lots appears to be contrary to the intent of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations and Development Regulations.

In addition, these lots do not meet the requirements of Section 304.1 of the BCZR, which states that the lots must predate 1955 and that the owner does not own sufficient adjoining property to meet the height and area requirements. For the reason stated above, the Office of Planning recommends that the applicant's request be denied.

It appears that the property owners, William and Vernell Marvel, own Lots 64, 65, 66, 67,68,69 and 70 in the subdivision of Baltimore Highlands. The Office of Planning has recently reviewed undersized lot requests for the properties located at 3017, 3021, and 3023 Ohio Avenue. In addition, the office also reviewed a variance for the property located at 3019 Ohio Ave. The assemblage of small lots—in single ownership—to create building lots appears to be contrary to the intent of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations and Development Regulations.

In addition, these lots do not meet the requirements of Section 304.1 of the BCZR, which states that the lots must predate 1955 and that the owner does not own sufficient adjoining property to meet the height and area requirements. For the reason stated above, the Office of Planning recommends that the applicant's request be denied.

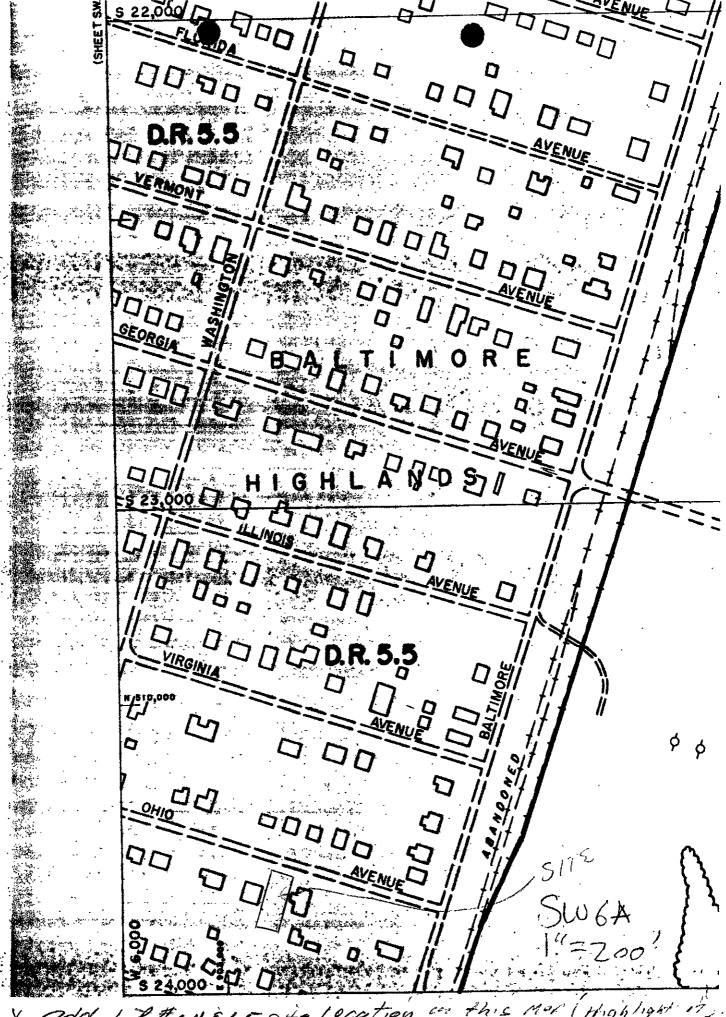
