### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owner of the subject property, Steve W. Wilson. The Petitioner requests variance relief from Sections 1B02.3.C.1 and 304 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a lot width of 59 feet in lieu of the required 70 feet, and to approve the subject property as an undersized lot for development with a single family dwelling. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request was Vincent Moskunas, a representative of Site Rite, Inc., a consultant retained by the Petitioner, who prepared the site plan for this property. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

The subject property is an unimproved, rectangular shaped parcel located on the east side of Bayside Drive, just north of that road's intersection with Bauernschmidt Drive in Essex. The property is known as Lot 60 of the Bauernschmidt Manor subdivision, which was recorded in the Land Records of Baltimore County in approximately 1940, prior to the adoption of the B.C.Z.R. The property consists of approximately 13,000 sq.ft. in area, zoned D.R.3.5. Although the property meets the minimum area requirements for a D.R.3.5-zoned lot, it lacks sufficient width at the building line. As more particularly shown on the site plan, the property is approximately 47 feet wide at its frontage adjacent to Bayside Drive, but tapers to an increased

width of 75 feet at the rear property line. The Petitioner proposes developing the property with a split-level dwelling, approximately 30 feet wide and 52 feet deep. At the front building wall of the proposed dwelling, the property is 59 feet wide. Thus, the requested variance is necessary. Additionally, although not waterfront, the property is located near Middle River and as such, is subject to the Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas regulations.

Additional testimony and evidence offered revealed that the Wilson family has owned the subject property for a number of years. In fact, the Petitioner owns the adjacent property, Lot 61, which is similarly shaped, in terms of a narrow frontage and greater width along the rear property line. That lot is, however, slightly larger in area and not identical to the subject property. Lot 61 is improved with a one-story frame dwelling which has existed on that property for many years. Both lots are separate lots of record as defined by the B.C.Z.R., and are separately taxed by Baltimore County. Although Lot 60 has been used as a large side yard for the existing dwelling on Lot 61, it is indeed a separate parcel. It is also to be noted that administrative variance relief was granted under Case No. 01-281-A to permit the existing one-story dwelling to remain on Lot 61. That is, relief was recently approved under that case number to permit the utilization of these two properties as separate building lots.

There were no Protestants at the hearing and no adverse Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments. Indeed, the Office of Planning supports the request to allow a lot width of 59 feet in lieu of the required 70 feet. As Mr. Moskunas noted at the hearing, there are similarly sized and shaped lots throughout Bauernschmidt Manor which have been improved with single family dwellings. This subdivision has been built out over the years on the lots as they were originally platted before the adoption of the B.C.Z.R.

Based upon the testimony and evidence offered, I am persuaded to grant the relief requested. Although similar to other lots in the neighborhood, the property is unique in terms of its configuration, size and the fact that same was platted before the adoption of the B.C.Z.R. I also find that the Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty if relief were denied and that development of the subject lot would not be detrimental to adjacent properties. It is to be noted

that the site is served by public water and sewer. It is also to be noted that development of the parcel will require compliance with the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area regulations, as administered by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) and set out in their ZAC comment dated February 1, 2001.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth herein, the relief requested shall be granted.

- 2) Construction of the proposed dwelling shall be in accordance with the building elevation drawings submitted to and approved by the Office of Planning on January 17, 2001.
- 3) The Petitioner shall comply with the requirements of the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area regulations as set forth in the ZAC comment submitted by DEPRM, dated February 1, 2001, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 4) When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

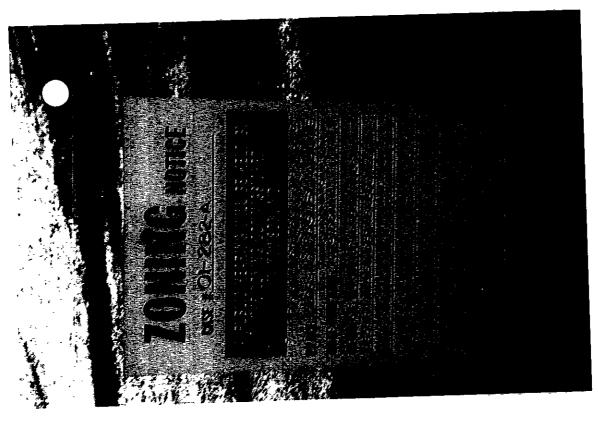

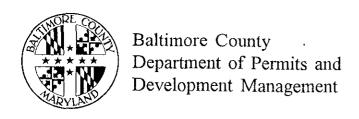

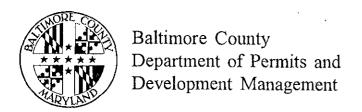

Zone in which such tract is located;
- 4. Any lot or tract of lots in single ownership which is not in an existing development or subdivision, as described in Subsection A.1 or A.2, and which is less than one-half acre in area, regardless of the number of dwelling or density units permitted at the maximum permitted density in the zone in which it is located; or
- Any lot or tract of lots in single ownership which is in a duly recorded subdivision plat not approved by the Baltimore County Planning Board or Planning Commission.
- B. Standards applicable to existing developments, etc. The minimum standards for net area, lot width, front yard depth, single-side-yard width, sum of widths of both side yards, rear yard depth and height with respect to each use in a development described in Subsection A.1 above, shall be as prescribed by the zoning regulations applicable to such use at the time the plan was approved by the Planning Board or Commission; however, the same or similar standards may be codified under Section 504, and these standards shall thereupon control in such existing developments.
