FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owners of the subject property, Scott E. and Kathy A. McKelvy. The Petitioners seek relief from Sections 400.1 and 400.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit an accessory structure (garage) to be located in the side yard with a height of 26 feet, in lieu of the required rear yard location and maximum height of 15 feet, respectively. The subject property and relief requested are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing held in support of the request were Scott McKelvey, property owner. Appearing as Protestants in the matter were Carol Shaw and Patricia L. Garner, on behalf of the Greater Kingsville Civic Association, Inc.

Testimony and evidence presented revealed that the subject property is an irregularly shaped parcel, located on the southeast side of Harford Road (Maryland Route 147), just north of its intersection with New Cut Road in Kingsville. The property contains a gross area of 9.198 acres, more or less, zoned R.C.2 and is presently unimproved. The site is mostly wooded with several forest conservation areas. Mr. McKelvey indicated that he and his wife recently purchased the property and wish to develop same with a single family dwelling, which features an attached three-car garage. In addition, a detached garage, 40' x 60' in dimension, with a height of 26 feet is proposed. The proposed improvements will be located towards the rear of the site, a significant

distance from Harford Road. Mr. McKelvey testified that the property is sloped and wooded and that the locations chosen for the proposed dwelling and garage were the most appropriate given the topography of the land. Mr. McKelvey indicated that he and his family desired a large piece of land and acquired the site for the purpose of building their residence.

The subject of the variance relates to the proposed detached garage. As noted above, the proposed structure will be 40' x 60' x 26' in dimension. Mr. McKelvey testified that the detached garage is for use and association with his hobby of collecting and restoring antique automobiles. He indicated that he has several old Chevrolet Corvettes and similar vehicles which he wishes to keep and rehabilitate. The three-car garage attached to the house will be used for his family's vehicles. Mr. McKelvey stressed that the use of the detached garage would be for his hobby purposes, only, and that his antique car collection is not a business. In this regard, he indicated that he is employed as a Sales Manager for a company that manufactures robotics for the automobile industry.

As to the variance request, Mr. McKelvey indicated that the detached garage cannot be placed in the rear yard due to the slope of the property, the location of the existing well and the septic reserve area. He indicated that the proposed location in the side yard would be most appropriate. It was also indicated that there are no immediately adjacent residences that would be impacted by the garage. The neighboring property owner's residence is located a significant distance away, and closer to Harford Road. The dwelling of the property owner to the rear of this site is also located a sufficient distance from the proposed improvements. As to the height variance, Mr. McKelvey indicated that he proposes constructing a loft on the building for storage purposes.

As noted above, Ms. Shaw and Ms. Garner appeared on behalf of the Greater Kingsville Civic Association. Their primary concerns were fears that the detached garage would be used for commercial purposes, or eventually converted as a dwelling unit. In response to these concerns, Mr. McKelvey stated that he had no intention of utilizing the building for any purposes other than his hobby and that it would not be used residentially. He also indicated that the garage

would be constructed so as to be aesthetically pleasing and similar in style and building materials to the proposed house.

Based on the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded to grant the requested variances. I find that the proposed location of the garage is appropriate by virtue of the site's unique topography. Indeed, this is a property with limited flat areas and construction to the rear of the proposed building envelope would be difficult. The height also seems appropriate, particularly in view of the rural nature of the locale. I am satisfied that the height of the proposed detached garage will not detrimentally impact surrounding properties. However, in granting the variances I will impose certain restrictions thereon. The building shall not be used for any dwelling purposes and cannot be converted into a dwelling unit at any time. In the event the property is ever rezoned and/or subdivided, this restriction shall remain in full force and effect, unless and until revoked by Order of the Zoning Commissioner's Office. Moreover, the garage shall not be used for any commercial purposes. The Petitioners shall not operate a business on this site and the building shall be used only to support Mr. McKelvey's hobby. Finally, at the request of the Office of Planning, I will require that the Petitioners submit building elevation drawings of the proposed dwelling and detached garage to that agency for review and approval and a determination that the buildings are appropriate and compatible with the surrounding locale and each other.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth herein, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this _______day of March, 2001 that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Sections 400.1 and 3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit an accessory structure (garage) to be located in the side yard with a height of 26 feet, in lieu of the required rear yard location and maximum height of 15 feet, respectively, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restrictions:

1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware

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that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.

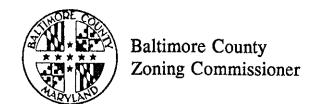
- 2) The proposed detached garage shall not be used for any dwelling purposes and cannot be converted into a dwelling unit at any time. In the event the property is ever rezoned and/or subdivided, this restriction shall remain in full force and effect, unless and until revoked by Order of the Zoning Commissioner's Office. Moreover, the garage shall not be used for any commercial purposes; the building shall be used only to support Mr. McKelvey's hobby or as an accessory building to the dwelling.
- 3) The Petitioners shall be required to submit building elevation drawings of the proposed dwelling and detached garage to the Office of Planning for review and approval, prior to the issuance of any building permits, to insure that the buildings are appropriate and compatible with the surrounding locale and each other.

4) When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

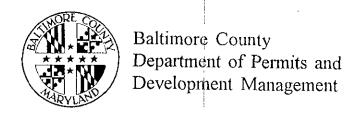

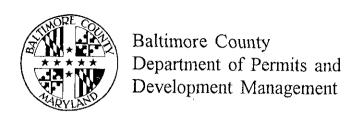

Dear Mr. Schmidt:

I am writing at the behest of the Board of Directors of The Greater Kingsville Civic Association with regard to Zoning Case # 01-285-A [12847 Harford Road, Hydes - 5th Councilmanic District, 10th Election District]. The property owners have requested a zoning variance to permit a garage to be located in the side yard with a height of 26 feet in lieu of the required rear yard and 15 foot maximum height, respectively.

Carol Shaw, Board member and an Officer of the Association, visited the property and, at her request, was given a survey map of the proposal by the Baltimore County Planning Department. The Board of Directors discussed the proposal and viewed the survey map at their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, February 21, 2001 and, a quorum being present, voted unanimously to oppose the granting of this variance.

The Association has several areas of concern with regard to this request for a variance for a "garage". This property is zoned RC-2 and, as such, is permitted by right one single-family detached house. The single family house which is currently being constructed on this property is, according to the survey map, to be 26 feet high with an attached three car garage. The septic reserve area is to one side of the house and the existing well to the other. There is nothing shown on the survey map as being an obstruction to building on the 100+ feet of available ground to the rear of the house.

The proposed variance to allow a detached "garage" to the side of the house appears unnecessary with regard to location. Additionally, the Board noticed that the height of the proposed detached "garage" is the same, e.g., 26 feet, as the house. It is also shown to be 60 feet by 40 feet in proposed area. That footprint of 60 feet by 40 feet is almost as big as the house which is to be 62 feet by 44 feet, excluding the attached three-car garage. To make a comparison, the footprint of the proposed detached "garage" is bigger than the footprint of most houses in the area.

The Board is concerned that if a variance is granted, the "garage" – through its size in conjunction with its height and its location at the side of the property – will be capable of readily being converted to a use contrary to one of the uses permitted by right under the RC-2 zoning.

Specifically, the Board is concerned that the building would/could be used as a second house on the property or for a commercial purpose. As this Commission is aware, property owners in this area have attempted in the recent past to have their zoning upgraded/changed after they have effectively circumvented the zoning regulations regarding usage of their property.

Therefore, we respectfully ask that you deny the request for a variance on this property.
