FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Hearing and Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, the Wells-McComas Post #2678 VFW, Inc., by and through Edward Wisnewski, its Commander. The special hearing and variance request are to approve an amendment to Special Exception Case No. 92-262-A for a revision to the proposed parking area and to permit the parking area to be constructed of stone in lieu of the required durable and dustless surface, to allow that parking area to be non-striped and to permit 134 parking spaces in lieu of the required 171.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the special hearing and variance requests were Phillip Medlein, appearing on behalf of the owner, Geoffrey Schultz, appearing on behalf of McKee & Associates, Inc., the engineers who prepared the site plan of the property and Howard Alderman, attorney at law, representing the Petitioners. There were also other community members in attendance at the hearing, all of whom supported the Petitioners' request.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this special hearing and variance request, consists of 6.89 acres, more or less, zoned DR 5.5. The subject

property is improved with an existing 1 story brick building which is the home of the Wells-McComas Post #2678 VFW. The subject property is located on the south side of North Point Boulevard at its intersection with Delmar Avenue. The Petitioners propose to add an additional parking lot in the area shown on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1, the site plan submitted into evidence. The additional parking lot is proposed to be constructed of crusher run stone in an effort to cut down on storm water runoff. The proposed parking lot is set back a sufficient distance from the rear of the homes of those residents who reside on Delmar Avenue. Therefore, they have no objection to the VFW proceeding with the installation of these new parking spaces. In order to proceed, the variances, as stated previously, and the special hearing request are necessary.

An area variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would cause practical difficulty to Petitioner and their property. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioner must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. Of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the variance is not granted. It has been
