FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, Aisha and Hussein Karachiwalla. The variance request is for property located at 1229 N. Rolling Road in the Catonsville area of Baltimore County. The Petitioners are requesting a variance from Section 424.1.B of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to allow a 48" chain link fence along the rear and side property lines of their property in lieu of the 5 ft. wooden stockade fence 20 ft. from the property lines.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the variance request was Hussein Karachiwalla, owner of the property. There were no protestants or others in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this variance request, consists of 0.5 acres, more or less, zoned DR 3.5. The subject property is improved with a single-family dwelling wherein the property owners operate a child care center. The Petitioners have lived in and operated the child care center for the past one year. The purpose of the variance request is to approve the existing chain link fence that is located along the rear and slide property lines. The Petitioners wish to continue to utilize the chain link fence as opposed to replacing it with a 5 ft. wooden stockade fence. In addition, they wish to leave the existing fence

on the property line in lieu of 20 ft. from the property line. In order to continue to use the chain link fence, the variance request is necessary.

An area variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would cause practical difficulty to the Petitioners and their property. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioners must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. Of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the variance is not granted. It has been established that special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the property which is the subject of this request and that the requirements from which the Petitioners seek relief will unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unique to this particular parcel. In addition, the relief requested will not cause any injury to the public health, safety or general welfare, and meets the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioners, I find that the Petitioners' variance request should be granted.
