#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owners of the subject property, Daniel F. and Elynor S. Henegan. The Petition was filed in response to a zoning violation notice the Petitioners received from the Code Enforcement Division of the Department of Permits and Development Management (DPDM) relative to an accessory structure constructed in the front of the subject property. The Petitioners were advised to file the instant Petition to correct the matter. Thus, the Petitioners filed the instant Petition seeking relief from Section 400.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit the subject accessory structure (a 28'x 20' shed) to be located in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were Daniel F. Henegan, property owner, and Gay Shaw, adjacent property owner. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is roughly rectangular in shape, and consists of a gross area of 10.0 acres, more or less, zoned R.C.2. The property is located approximately 2,150 feet southeast of Old York Road, on the north side of a private road, in Monkton. The site is improved with a two-story dwelling and two outbuildings, including a barn and small, run-in shed. A two-story addition to the existing dwelling is presently under

construction. In addition, the Petitioner recently commenced constructing a 28' x 20' accessory building in the front yard of his property, adjacent to the existing driveway. It is this structure that is the subject of the instant variance request.

Mr. Henegan indicated that access to his lot is via a one-half mile long private road/driveway that leads from Old York Road. Since the driveway is private, it is not County-maintained or plowed following snowstorms. In this regard, Mr. Henegan indicated that he recently purchased a farm truck and tractor which will be used to maintain the driveway. In order to have immediate access to these vehicles in the location where they are most needed during inclement weather, the Petitioner wishes to have the structure in the front yard, adjacent to the driveway. Testimony indicated that the structure will be attractive so as not to detract from his property or have an adverse impact on his neighbor's property.

Based on the testimony and evidence offered, I am persuaded to grant the variance. The uniqueness of the property lies in the unusual length and private nature of the driveway. I find that the Petitioners would suffer a practical difficulty if strict adherence to the regulations were required, and that relief can be granted without detrimental impact to adjacent properties. It is to be noted that there were no adverse Zoning Advisory Committee comments submitted by any Baltimore County reviewing agency and no one appeared in opposition to the request. In fact, the most immediately affected neighbor, Ms. Shaw, appeared in support of the Petitioner's request.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth herein, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of April, 2001 that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Section 400.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit an accessory structure (28'x 20' shed) to be located in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restriction:

1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware

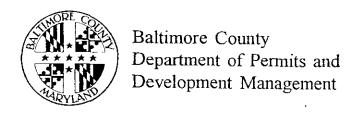

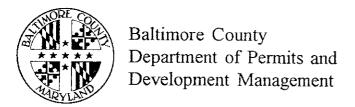
